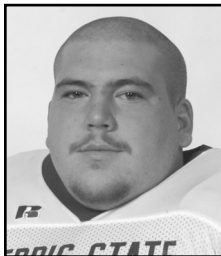


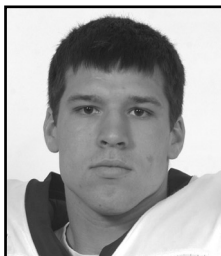

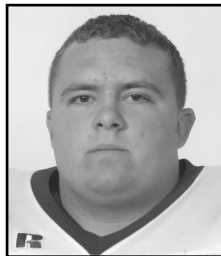

Earned starting nod in six of 10 games played in 2002 season . . . Played in four outings for 2001 campaign . . . Started out at defensive tackle . . . Garnered All-Capital Circuit Conference First-Team accolades as a senior at Lumen Christi High . . . Coached by Herb Brogan . . . Served as team captain and was named to the *Jackson Citizen Patriot's* Dream Team in 1999 . . . Member of '96 Class B State Championship team as a frosh . . .
