Coming off a great spring of work at flanker . . . Will battle for playing time at a deep position this year . . . Shifty runner . . . Displays good quickness . . . Has excellent hands . . . Possession type receiver . . . A great route runner who finds open areas well . . . Level of consistency will likely dictate amount of action . . . Spent two seasons at cornerback before moving to offense last spring . . . Saw action in six contests a season ago . . . Best outing was two receptions for 28 yards, which included a 16-yard catch in the season finale at Indianapolis (11/16) . . . Played in nine games in 2000 as a reserve and only tackle was at Indianapolis (11/11) . . . All-league selection and team captain at Miramar High . . . Passed for 1,300 yards and 13 TD's in senior campaign . . . FSU Letters: Two . . . Birthdate: 10/4/80 . . . Major: Computer Information Systems.
