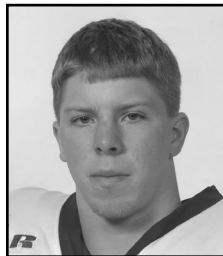

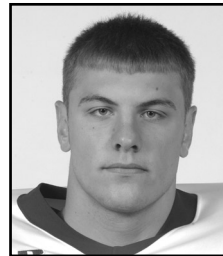

5-10 ♦ 195 ♦ Sophomore
Clinton Township (Clintondale)

Solid backup . . . Provides quality depth at the free safety position and could push for playing time . . . Played well in spring ball . . . Has been hampered by injuries the last two seasons . . . Good tackler and cover guy . . . Intense competitor . . . 2002 FSU Dean's Academic Award recipient . . . Didn't receive game action last season due to injury . . . A first-team division four selection in senior year at Clintondale High . . . Achieved H.M. all-state recognition by the *Associated Press* and *Detroit News* . . . Coached by Jim Scarcelli . . . Two-time all-conference first-team selection and was conference MVP in 1999 . . . Attained All-Macomb County First-Team kudos in '99 . . . Recorded 86 tackles with two interceptions as a senior . . . Threw for 634 yards and seven TD's in final prep campaign to earn team offensive MVP honors . . . Younger brother, Chris, also competes in football at FSU . . . Birthdate: 6/26/81 . . . Talented redshirt linebacker . . . Expected to be a key player on specialty teams . . . Showed promise in spring drills . . . Has a great work ethic . . . Solid student . . . Two-time all-state and All-Highland Conference selection at Beal City High . . . Prepped by Lou Rau . . . 2002 graduate . . . Named to *The Morning Sun's* Dream Team twice and was honored as the captain as a senior . . . Two-time team MVP Award recipient . . . Amassed 193 tackles with six quarterback sacks during senior year . . . Compiled 148 stops, which included 12 sacks, along with two pass interceptions as a junior . . . Also competed in baseball and basketball four years each . . . Served as school class president and member of student council all four years . . . Excellent athlete . . . Back for this third year in a starting capacity . . . A highly-accurate lefthanded passer with a strong arm . . . Well-versed in making reads at the line of scrimmage . . . Can roll and throw effectively on the run . . . Needs to take his game to the next level . . . Ranks fifth among the program's all-time passing leaders . . . Threw for a career-high 2,350 yards (sixth best in school history) and 10 TD's in 10 games last fall . . . Posted six 200-yard plus single-game passing performances . . . Passed for 396 yards and two TD's at Findlay (11/2) . . . Turned in a 377-yard and three TD effort at Northwood (10/5) . . . Selected FSU's Outstanding Offensive Rookie in 2001 . . . Passed for 1,537 yards and 15 TD's in nine outings in '01 . . . Passing total in '01 ranks 16th highest among all-time single-season leaders . . . Selected GLIAC Offensive Player of the Week following 334-yard, four TD passing effort at Wayne State (9/22) . . . Compiled four 200-yard plus game passing efforts . . . Ranked fifth among GLIAC's passing leaders (170.8 ypg.) . . . An all-stater at Evergreen Park High . . . Prepped by Brett Nelson . . . Two-time All-Suburban Prairie Conference and regional all-area selection . . . Honored as the Chicago Southtown All-Area and regional Player-of-the-Year in senior year . . . FSU Letters: Two . . . Returns to starting outside post . . . Intense and aggressive . . . Fastest LB on team and one of the strongest . . . Solid tackler . . . Has a physical presence on the field . . . Didn't compete in spring ball . . . 2002 FSU Outstanding Defensive Rookie . . . His career-best 92 tackles in 10 contests last fall was third best among FSU's leading tacklers . . . Compiled four double-digit game tackle efforts, including 17 stops at Northwood (10/5) . . . Made 15 tackles vs. Wayne State (9/28) and 13 at Mercyhurst (10/19) . . . Had an 11-yard interception return at Findlay (11/2) . . . Registered season-high two tackles apiece vs. Findlay (9/8) and Michigan Tech (10/20) in 2001 . . . Unanimous first-team All-Southeastern Conference and all-area linebacker at Chelsea High . . . Prepped by Brad Bush . . .
