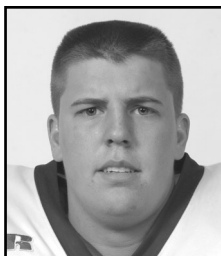

Posted season-high four tackles against Michigan Tech (10/20) in 2001 . . . Notched three stops apiece vs. Findlay (9/8) and at Hillsdale (11/3) . . . 2000 FSU Tomorrow's Team Defensive Player-of-the-Year . . . Coached by Bob Scheloske at South Lyon High . . . A *Detroit Free Press* all-state selection in senior season . . . Two-time all-conference and team defensive MVP . . . Older brother, Ryan, was a defensive tackle at FSU (1997-00) . . . 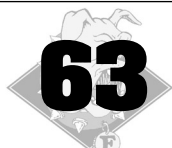

Posted seven double-figure game tackle outings, including 17 stops at Northwood (10/5), 16 at Findlay (11/2) and 15 vs. Ashland (11/9) . . . Ranked tied for 12th place nationally in tackles (11.1 avg.) and second among GLIAC leaders . . . Had a 14-yard interception return at Indianapolis (11/16) and 11-yarder at Northern Michigan (9/21) . . . FSU's Outstanding Defensive Rookie in 2001 . . . His 49 tackles was ninth best on '01 squad . . . Tallied season-high 14 tackles at Mercyhurst (10/13) . . . Three-time all-conference and all-area pick at Midland High . . . Prepped by Terry Wilczek . . . D2Football.com NE Region and GLIAC Special Teams Player of the Week after connecting on all three field goal attempts vs. Indianapolis (11/10) in a double overtime win, which included a 42-yarder and a game-winning 34-yarder vs. Indianapolis (11/10) . . . Ranked tied for 31st nationally in forced fumbles (0.30 avg.) . . . Received honorable mention All-GLIAC accolades in 2001 . . . Compiled a team-high 110 tackles in '01 and tallied six double-digit tackle games . . . Recorded 15 stops at Northern Michigan (10/27) and 13 at Mercyhurst (10/13) . . . His 51 tackles in 2000 ranked ninth on the team . . . Had season-high 12 tackles vs. Mercyhurst (10/14) before suffering a season-ending injury . . .
