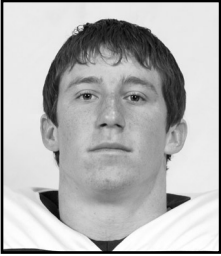

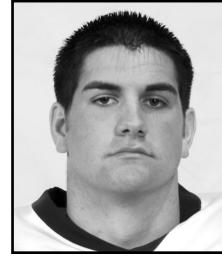

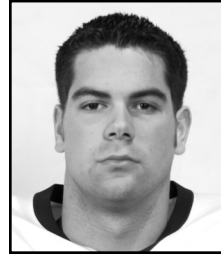

Dominating starting right tackle . . . Preseason honors candidate . . . A 2003 second-team All-America and Northeast Region First-Team selection by *Hansen's Football Gazette* . . . Named to All-GLIAC First Team and was FSU's Most Valuable Defensive Lineman in '03 after notching a career-high 99 tackles in 10 games to tie for third place on team . . . Posted five double-digit tackle games, which included 18 stops (14 solo) vs. Findlay (11/1) and 15 (nine solo) at Ashland (11/8) . . . Recorded double-figure tackle totals in the season's last five outings . . . Tops among GLIAC defensive linemen in tackles (9.9 avg.) and ranked sixth nationally in solo stops (6.4 avg.) and 25th in tackles for loss (1.7 avg.) . . . Nine-game starter in 2002 and was FSU's Most Improved Defensive Player . . . Ranked sixth in team tackles with 62 total . . . Tallied season-best 10 tackles twice - at Northwood (10/5) and at Mercyhurst (10/19) . . . Played all 11 2001 contests . . . Notched two tackles vs. Grand Valley State (10/6) and at Northern Michigan (10/27) . . . Earned all-state laurels at Sault Area High under coach Barry Pierson . . . Two-time All-Upper Peninsula Dream Team and Big North Conference pick . . . Competed in hockey . . . Both parents are teachers . . . FSU Letters: Three . . . Birthdate: 12/28/81 . . .
