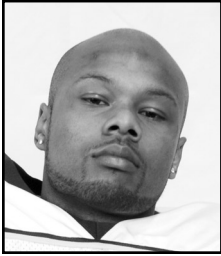
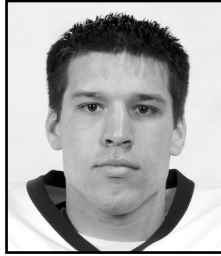

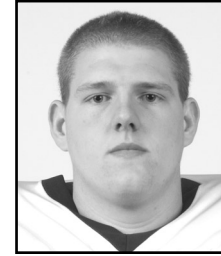

 Kalamazoo (Central)

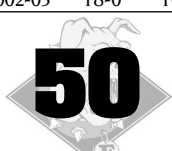

Did You Know?

Ferris State is 39-49-5 (.446) all-time in season-opening contests since 1900 and have won nine of its last 15 openers to date. Conversely, the Bulldogs are 35-51-7 (.414) in season finales dating back to that period and 40-46-7 (.468) in regular-season finale encounters. Since 1985, FSU is 14-5 (.737) in its last regular-season outings.
