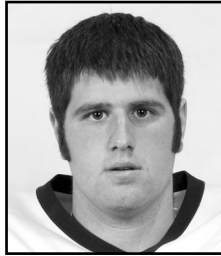

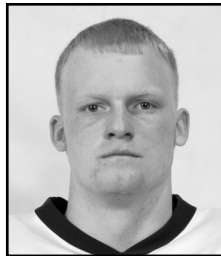

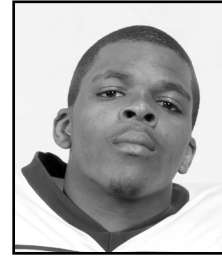

Ranked tied for second in league sacks (0.80 avg.) and tied for fourth in tackles for loss (1.35 avg.) . . . Posted 10 stops at Hillsdale (9/6) with three sacks (-19 yds.) . . . Recorded nine tackles apiece vs. Northwood (10/4) and Indianapolis (11/15) . . . Made eight stops vs. Mercyhurst (10/18), which included 3.5 sacks (-28 yds.) and also had eight at Wayne State (9/27) . . . '03 FSU Dean's Academic Award winner . . . Three-time (2001-03) GLIAC All-Academic honoree . . . Was team's FSU President's Academic Award recipient in 2002 for highest gpa . . . Ranked 14th among squad's top '02 tacklers . . . Posted season-high seven stops (two tackles for -10 yds.) vs. Wayne State (9/28) . . . Had four tackles vs. Michigan Tech (10/12) . . . His 25 tackles in 2001 was 14th highest on the team . . . Notched a season-high five stops vs. Findlay (9/8) . . . Two-time All-Mid Michigan Conference "A" lineman at St. Johns High . . . Coached by Bob McConnell . . . Named conference's "Defensive End & Running Back of the Year" in '99 . . . Holds school game records for rushing TD's and points along with most rushing TD's in a season . . .
