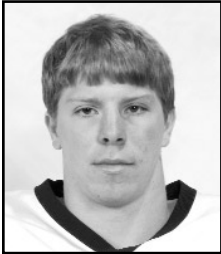

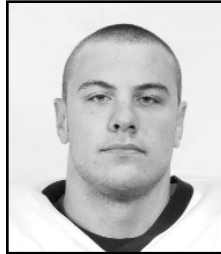

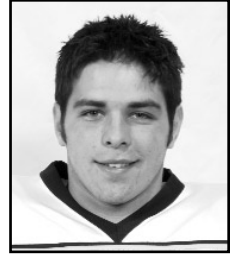

Talented linebacker . . . Will contend for action at both outside positions and is one of the Bulldogs' best specialty teams performers . . . Had an outstanding spring . . . Has a great work ethic . . . Top-notch student . . . 2003 GLIAC All-Academic and co-FSU President's Academic Award (team's highest gpa) recipient . . . Placed 14th among FSU's 2003 tackles leaders . . . Made a season-high seven tackles vs. Northwood (10/4) . . . Had five stops (four solo) vs. Mercyhurst (10/18) . . . Two-time all-state and All-Highland Conference selection at Beal City High . . . Prepped by Lou Rau . . . 2002 graduate . . . Excellent athlete . . . Returns for his fourth year as the starter . . . A left-handed thrower with a strong arm . . . Can roll and throw effectively on the run . . . Needs to take his game to the next level . . . Displayed improvement in the spring, particularly in decision-making . . . Good leader . . . Ranks fifth among the program's all-time passing leaders . . . Passed for 1,983 yards and 12 TD's last season with passing yardage ranking 13th best on FSU season leaders list . . . Compiled six 200-yard or more passing efforts, highlighted by a 297-yard, three TD effort at Michigan Tech (10/11) . . . Had 231 aerial yards with a TD at Hillsdale (9/6) and threw for at least 100 yards in season's final eight games . . . Threw for a career-high 2,350 yards (sixth best at FSU) and 10 TD's in 2002 . . . Posted six 200-yard plus single-game passing performances . . . Threw for 396 yards and two TD's at Findlay (11/2) and 377 yards with three TD's at Northwood (10/5) . . . Selected 2001 FSU's Outstanding Offensive Rookie after passing for 1,537 yards (17th highest on school charts) and 15 TD's . . . Selected GLIAC Offensive Player of the Week following 334-yard, four TD passing effort at Wayne State (9/22) . . . Had four 200-yard plus passing efforts . . . Only season reception was a seven-yarder in season finale vs. Indianapolis (11/15) . . . 2002 GLIAC All-Academic Team . . . His 13 receptions in 2002 ranked sixth on squad . . . Appeared in 10 contests for 2002 campaign after competing in 11 the previous year . . . Had seven catches for 72 yards vs. Hillsdale (9/7) . . . Both '01 receptions came against Findlay (9/8) . . . Returns for his third season as a starter . . . Intense and aggressive . . . Team's fastest LB and one of the strongest . . . Solid tackler . . . Excellent athlete . . . A honorable mention All-GLIAC pick in 2003 . . . Placed sixth among '03 FSU tackles leaders with 88 total . . . Recorded season-best nine stops five times – at Grand Valley State (9/13), vs. Northern Michigan (9/20), vs. Mercyhurst (10/18), at Saginaw Valley State (10/25) and vs. Indianapolis (11/15) . . . 2002 FSU Outstanding Defensive Rookie . . . His 92 tackles in '02 was third best among FSU's leaders . . . Compiled four double-digit game tackle efforts, including 17 at Northwood (10/5) and 15 vs. Wayne State (9/28) . . . Had an 11-yard interception return at Findlay (11/2) . . . Registered two tackles apiece vs. Findlay (9/8) and Michigan Tech (10/20) in 2001 . . .
