A 2004 preseason All-American by several publications . . . Received 2003 All-America First-Team honors by the *Associated Press*, American Football Coaches Association while attaining second-team kudos by *Daktronics* and *Hansen's Football Gazette* . . . Also picked up *D2Football.com* All-America HM laurels . . . Ranks 14th in career tackles . . . 2003 All-GLIAC First Team and FSU's Most Valuable Defensive Skill Player . . . Posted a conference-best 141 tackles in '03 which ranked 13th highest on FSU's all-time season charts . . . Placed second nationally in solo tackles (12.8 avg.), fourth in total tackles (12.8 avg.) and fourth in forced fumbles (0.45 avg.) . . . Had eight double-digit tackle games, including career-high 23 vs. Findlay (11/1) and 16 at Saginaw Valley State (10/25) . . . 2002 All-GLIAC Second Team . . . Had a team-high 112 tackles in '02 . . . Posted seven double-figure tackle outings, including 17 at Northwood (10/5) . . . Ranked tied for 12th place nationally in tackles (11.1 avg.) and second among GLIAC leaders . . .
