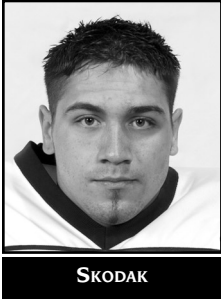


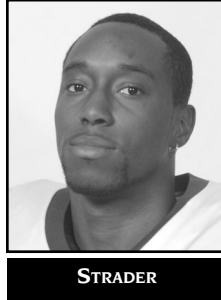

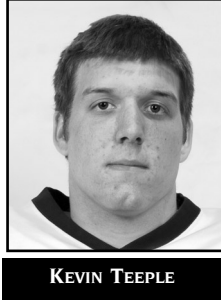

Dual-purpose kicker . . . Will start fall camp as the frontrunner at punter . . . Has a strong leg with good hangtime . . . Gets notable distance on punts . . . Developing specialist . . . Needs to continue consistency . . . Garnered first-team all-league honors as a punter, kicker and receiver in senior season at Polo High . . . Prepped by Ted Alston . . . Voted team MVP along with picking up all-area kudos as a senior . . . Averaged 34.0 yards per punt attempt and connected on 19-of-22 extra points during senior year . . . Had 23 receptions for 355 yards and six TD's while notching 41 tackles and a league-best eight interceptions on defense in 2002 season . . . Recorded a 36.0 yard average in punts and made good on three-of-four field goal attempts as a junior en route to all-conference first-team laurels . . . Racked up 40 yards on six attempts vs. Mercyhurst (10/18) while running for 21 yards on five carries at Wayne State (9/27) . . . Rushed for 106 yards and two TDs on 24 carries in eight 2002 outings . . . Gained a career-best 49 yards with a TD (three yards) on 11 carries vs. Ashland (11/9) . . . Had five rush attempts for 17 yards vs. Saginaw Valley State (10/26) . . . Scored on a 10-yard TD scamper at Findlay (11/2) . . . Caught a season-best five-yard aerial at Northwood (10/5) . . . Ran for a season-high 26 yards on five attempts vs. Grand Valley State (10/6) in 2001 and gained 23 yards on nine carries with a seven-yard catch vs. Michigan Tech (10/20) . . . An All-American and all-state pick as a senior at Creston High . . . Prepped by Sparky McEwen, a former FSU quarterback . . . Named to the 1999 Michigan Dream Team . . .
