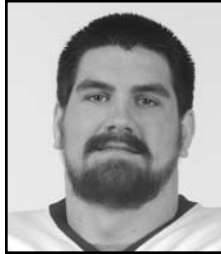

DID YOU KNOW?

Ferris State is 39-51-5 (.437) all-time in season-opening contests since 1900 and have won nine of its last 17 season openers to date. The Bulldogs are 35-53-7 (.405) in season finales dating back to that period and 40-48-7 (.458) in regular-season finale encounters. Since 1985, FSU is 14-7-0 (.667) in its final regular-season outing.
