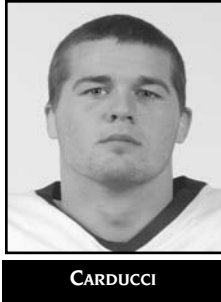


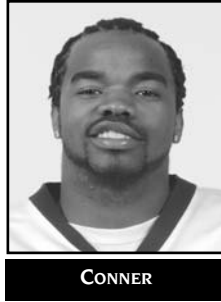

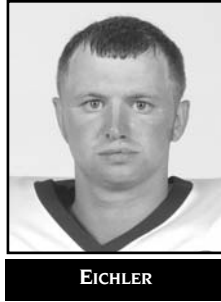

Elusive slot receiver... Deep threat... Fast and quick... Placed fourth among 2005 team receiving leaders with 25 catches for 253 yards in 11 games... Started in five 2005 outings... Had a team-high 406 yards on 19 kickoff returns which ranked 71st nationally (21.4 ypr)... Netted season-high 67 receiving yards on four grabs vs. Northwood (10/29)... Caught two passes for 37 yards vs. Northern Michigan (10/15)... Had five receptions for 25 yards vs. Indianapolis (9/17)... Totaled 121 yards on six kickoff returns at North Dakota (10/8) and 80 yards on two returns at Findlay (10/1)... Played two seasons (2003-04) at the College of DuPage in Glen Ellyn, Ill...
