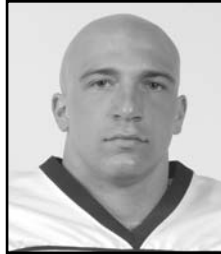

Ranked 33rd among 2005 national leaders in total offense (244.9 ypg.) and 39th in pass efficiency (133.0) . . . Named GLIAC Offensive Player of the Week (10/17) following 330-yard, four TD passing effort vs. Northern Michigan . . . Passed for career-high 393 yards and three TD's at Findlay (10/1) and 320 yards along with two TD's at Saginaw Valley State (11/5) . . . Also ran for season-best 57 yards and two TD's in the NMU contest . . . Passed for 1,375 yards and nine TD's in 10 2004 games and was FSU's Outstanding Offensive Rookie . . . Started in eight 2004 outings . . . Compiled seven 100-yard plus game passing efforts, including 257 yards at Mercyhurst (9/25) . . . Threw for 148 yards at Indianapolis (9/18) while running for 103 yards . . . Had 206 passing yards (15-21) and a TD against Hillsdale (9/11) which included 61 rushing yards . . . Threw for 159 yards and a TD vs. Northern Michigan (9/20) in 2003 . . . Earned all-state second-team honors at Clarkston High under coach Kurt Richardson . . . Outstanding linebacker and an All-America candidate . . . Exceptional student with an excellent work ethic . . . Plays with intensity . . . Two-time (2004-05) All-GLIAC H.M. and GLIAC All-Academic Team honoree . . . 2005 FSU Most Valuable Player and Most Valuable Defensive Skill Player . . . 2005 FSU President's Academic Award winner and two-time (2003-04) co-recipient for highest team gpa . . . Named to 2005 ESPN *The Magazine* Academic District IV First Team . . . Racked up a team-leading 109 tackles last fall in 10 games . . . Talled five consecutive double-digit tackle game performances in 2005, including 17 stops vs. Indianapolis (9/17) and 15 hits vs. Ashland (9/3) . . . Made 13 tackles apiece at Hillsdale (9/10) and vs. Mercyhurst (9/24) . . . Ranked 14th among 2005 national leaders in total tackles (10.9 avg.), 45th in solo tackles (4.9 avg.), and 100th in forced fumbles (0.2 avg.) . . . 2004 FSU Coaches Award co-winner . . .
