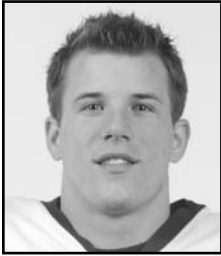

Experienced defender... Projected to start at strong safety for second straight season... One of secondary's fastest runners... Physical player... Has good size-speed combination... Started all 11 games a season ago and his career-high 68 tackles was fifth highest on the team... Compiled a career-best 11 tackles (six solos) at Saginaw Valley State (11/5)... Made 10 stops at Hillsdale (9/10) while tallying seven apiece (six solos) vs. Indianapolis (9/17) and (seven solos) at Michigan Tech (10/22)... Racked up six tackles each at Grand Valley State (8/27) and vs. Northwood (10/29)... Had a one-yard pass interception return at Findlay (10/1)... Competed in eight 2004 contests... Notched two tackles at Indianapolis (9/18)... Achieved all-state H.M. and all-state academic team honors in senior year at Clintondale High... Coached by Jim Scarcelli... Talented linebacker... Has an outstanding work ethic... Top-notch student... Two-time (2003 & 2005) GLIAC All-Academic pick... Two-time (2004-05) FSU Dean's Academic Award honoree... Started all 11 2005 games at the "Will" position and was fourth in team tackles with a career-high 77 stops... Registered 11 tackles in season opener at Grand Valley State (8/27) and 10 stops at Hillsdale (9/10)... Posted eight tackles apiece at Michigan Tech (10/22) and vs. Northwood (10/29)... Had a 16-yard interception return vs. Indianapolis (9/17) and a two-yard pass theft return vs. Mercyhurst (9/24)... Suffered season-ending injury in 2004 opener vs. Grand Valley State (8/28)... 2003 FSU President's Academic Award (team's highest gpa) co-recipient... His 22 stops ranked 14th among FSU's 2003 tackles leaders... Made a season-high seven tackles vs. Northwood (10/4)... Two-time all-state and All-Highland Conference pick at Beal City High...
