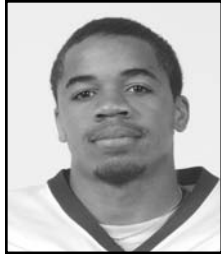

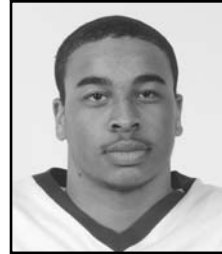

Booted a season-high 64-yard punt at Michigan Tech and had a 53-yarder at Saginaw Valley State . . . Posted three kicks 50-plus yards on the season . . . Team's primary kickoff specialist . . . **DID YOU KNOW?**  
 Ferris State sports a 32-16-9 (.640) record in its final three regular-season contests per campaign dating back to 1990. The Bulldogs are 15-9-0 at home (.625) and 17-7-0 on the road (.708) during that period. Since 1992, FSU is 14-8-0 (.636) at Top Taggart Field in its final three season appearances.
