***GOLF WORLD* ANNOUNCES RESULTS OF FOURTH
MEN'S COLLEGE COACHES' POLL OF THE SPRING SEASON**

Columbus State Retains Top Spot in D-II Poll

NEW YORK, NY—The fourth *Golf World*/Nike Golf Division II Coaches' Poll of the spring season has been released, combining the resources of *Golf World* magazine, Nike Golf and the Golf Coaches Association of America (GCAA). The complete results, including results from Divisions I, III and the NAIA, will appear in the April 27th issue of *Golf World* and can be viewed online now at www.golfworld.com.

Columbus State remains the number one team in the D-II poll, earning 10 of the 16 first-place votes. The Cougars have three victories this season and eight top-four finishes, and will attempt to claim the Peach Belt Conference championship this week.

Rounding out the top-five are Georgia College (No. 2), Nova Southeastern (No. 3), Central Oklahoma (No. 4) and USC Aiken (No. 5).

Indianapolis (No. 10) cracked the top-10, after being ranked No. 12 in the previous coaches' poll. Ferris State (No. 25) moved into the top-25.
