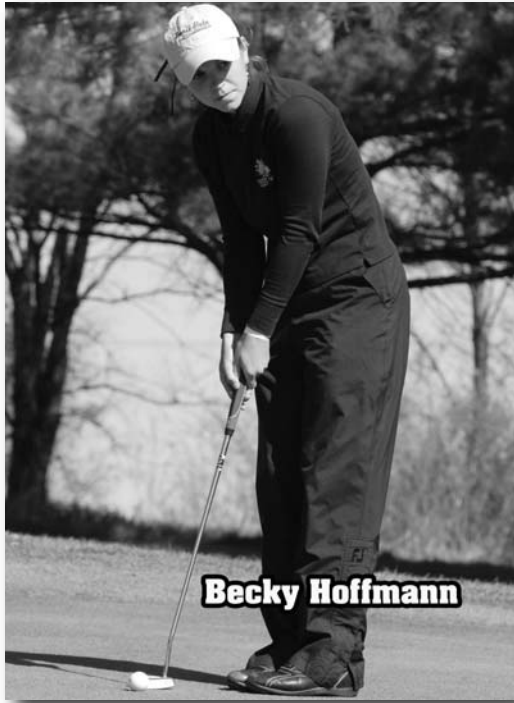
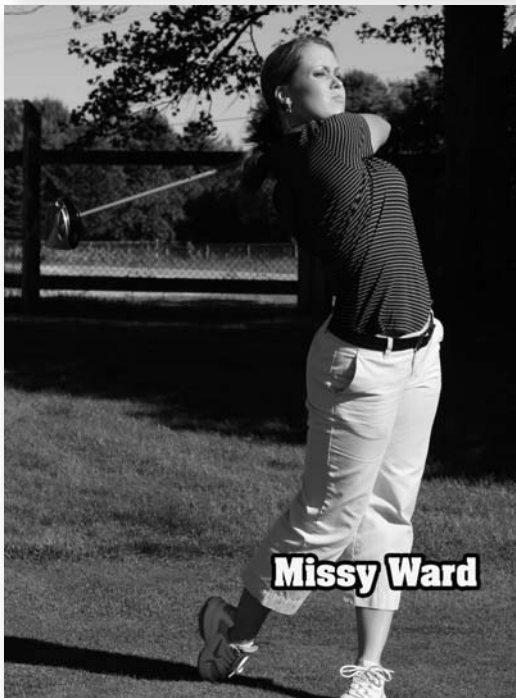

FERRIS STATE'S KATKE GOLF COURSE

Katke Golf Course, a university-owned 18-hole golf course situated on the western flank of the Ferris State campus, serves as the host site for the 2006 Bulldog Women's Invitational.

The course, which also serves as the site of all home Bulldog cross country along with men's and women's golf events, is named after Mr. and Mrs. Marvin L. Katke, whose generous donation influenced campus development and the initial phase of the golf course. Katke, a friend of Ferris and a Mecosta County native, was vice president for manufacturing of the Ford Motor Company and a 1967 recipient of an honorary degree from FSU.

The Katke Golf Course, which opened in 1974, played host to the 2004 Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) and NCAA Division II East Regional Women's Golf Championships.

A new clubhouse, which was added in the summer of 1999, houses the Professional Golf Management (PGM) Learning Center at Ferris State. The PGM program, which is designed for the individual who is interested in a career as a golf professional, has over 300 students and is a source of national recognition and a revenue producer for the university. Established in 1975, the PGM program was the first of its kind in the nation sanctioned by the prestigious Professional Golfers' Association of America (PGA).

Both the building and course also serve as a recreational resource for the entire community and surrounding area.
