**GOLF WORLD ANNOUNCES RESULTS OF SECOND
WOMEN'S COLLEGE COACHES' POLL OF THE SPRING SEASON**

Nova Southeastern Replaces Florida Southern as Top Team in D-II Poll

NEW YORK, NY—The second *Golf World*/NGCA Division II Coaches' Poll of the spring season has been released, combining the resources of *Golf World* magazine and the National Golf Coaches Association (NGCA). The complete results, including results from Divisions I and III, will appear in the March 30 issue of *Golf World* and can be viewed online now at www.golfworld.com.

Nova Southeastern claimed the top spot away from Florida Southern (No. 2), earning all eight first-place votes. The Knights won the Peggy Kirk Bell Invitational, beating both Florida Southern and No. 3 Rollins, for their fourth team title of the season.

Lynn (No. 4) and Grand Valley State (No. 5) round out the top-five.

St. Edward's (No. 10) joined the top-10, after being ranked T-12 in the previous coaches' poll. Saint Leo (No. 24) moved into the top-25, after winning its first two tournaments of the spring.
