## GAME 33-34 ▲ 2006-07 SEASON

**THIS WEEKEND:** The Ferris State University men's ice hockey team will close out the home portion of its 2006-07 regular-season schedule this weekend (Feb. 16-17) as the Bulldogs square off the Bowling Green State University Falcons in a two-game Central Collegiate Hockey Association (CCHA) series at Big Rapids, Mich. The games represent the first and only regular-season meetings between the two teams for the 2006-07 campaign.

**FACEOFF/ARENA:** Friday – 7:05 p.m. (EST) & Saturday – 5:05 p.m. (EST)/Ewigleben Ice Arena (*pronounced A-VAH-glave-in*) (2,493).

**THE BROADCAST:** All of Ferris State's 2006-07 CCHA games will be carried live by local radio station **Big Country WWBR-100.9 FM with Bill Beckwith** calling the action. The contests can be accessed live via the internet by clicking on the Bulldog Athletics Webcasts icon at [www.ferris.edu/sports](http://www.ferris.edu/sports).

**THE RECORDS:** Ferris State improved to 10-19-3 overall and 7-15-2 in CCHA action with a 2-1 league victory over the nationally fifth-ranked Michigan State Spartans on Tuesday (Feb. 13) at FSU's Ewigleben Ice Arena in Big Rapids, Mich. The win snapped the Spartans' nine-game (7-0-2) unbeaten streak. The Bulldogs, who are now 4-4-0 in their last eight contests to date, have compiled a 7-8-1 home record this campaign. ◀ Last season, Ferris State was 17-15-8 overall with a sixth place-tying 10-11-7 CCHA record. The Bulldogs were 8-6-4 at home.

**Bowling Green State** is presently 6-24-2 overall and 4-19-1 in the CCHA following a 3-2 league win against the nationally-ranked Michigan Wolverines last Friday (Feb. 9) at the BGSU Ice Arena in Bowling Green, Ohio. The victory snapped the Falcons' 10-game (0-9-1) non-winning streak as BG's last triumph came in a 5-1 home decision over Western Michigan (Jan. 5). The Falcons are 2-15-0 on the road and 4-9-2 at home this campaign.

◀ A season ago, Bowling Green compiled a 13-23-2 overall record with a 12th-place 8-18-2 CCHA ledger. The Falcons were 3-13-1 in away

outings.

**THE COACHES: Ferris State – Bob Daniels** (Michigan State, 1982), 15th season, 235-283-51 (.458) – (20-15-6 vs. Bowling Green State – 11-5-3 Home, 9-10-3 Away). **Bowling Green State – Scott Paluch** (Bowling Green State, 1991), 5th season, 54-106-20 (.356) – (1-7-2 vs. Ferris State). Paluch earned All-America and All-CCHA First Team honors as a senior at BGSU in the 1987-88 season. He served as an associate head coach at Boston College from 1995-02 prior to becoming the fifth coach in the 34-year history of BGSU Hockey on April 15, 2002.

**ABOUT BOWLING GREEN STATE:** Junior forward Jonathan Matsumoto (10-17=27) leads seven Falcons in double-figure points totals. Matsumoto is BGSU's top returning scorer from a season ago with 48 points (20-28=48) in 36 contests. Junior forward Derek Whitmore (13-9=22) along with freshmen forwards Tomas Petruska (8-7=15) and Todd McIlrath (5-9=14). Sophomore goaltender Jimmy Spratt (5-17-1, 3.63 GAA, .884sv%) has started all 25 games played in while freshman Eddie Neville (1-7-1, 4.18 GAA, .860sv%) has competed in 10 contests this season.

➤ **Streak Ends** – Senior left wing **Matt Verdone's (Summerstown, Ontario)** had his career-high 10-game point streak snapped versus Michigan State Tuesday (1/13). In the 10 contests, Verdone racked up 13 points (6-7=13). He's one point shy of tying his career season-best 23 points (15-8=23) in 38 contests last season and presently has racked up 22 points (10-12=22) in 32 games this campaign.

➤ **He Likes The CCHA** – Sophomore left wing **Brendan Connolly (Canmore, Alberta)** has compiled a career-best 17 points (10-7=17) in 31 contests this season with 14 points (8-6=14) occurring in CCHA play. Connolly produced seven points (1-6=7) in 36 games for the 2005-06 season.

➤ **Career High** – Senior defenseman **Joe Van Culin's (Monticello, Minn.)** 12 points (4-8=12) in 32 contests this season represents a career high, eclipsing his 11 points (3-8=11) in 39 outings for the 2004-05 campaign. Van Culin, who has tallied at least a point in three (0-4=4) of his last four contests, was selected as a finalist for the Pontiac Frozen Four Skills Challenge at the 2007 NCAA Men's Ice Hockey Frozen Four (April 6) in St. Louis, Mo. Voting concluded Feb. 12 and the participants will be announced in mid to late February. Van Culin, FSU's 2004-05 CCHA Scholar-Athlete of the Year, had three points (1-2=3) in 27 games a season ago in the squad's first 31 contests.

➤ **Productive 2007** – Junior goaltender **Derek MacIntyre (Stanwood)** improved to 5-1-0 in 2007 with Tuesday's (1/13) decision over Michigan State. MacIntyre has produced a 3.37 goals-against average (22 goals allowed) and an .888 saves percentage (174 saves) in those seven 2007 contests. MacIntyre, a 2004-05 CCHA All-Rookie Honorable Mention Team selection, totaled 23 stops against the Spartans and is averaging 27.3 saves (82 total) in his last three appearances. A 2004 eighth-round draft pick of the San Jose Sharks, MacIntyre began 2007 with wins in his first three outings – at Northern Michigan (1/6), at Wayne State (1/13), and versus Nebraska-Omaha (1/20) with 35 stops. MacIntyre made only one 2006 appearance during the 2005-06 campaign and made 20 saves in a 5-0 loss at Northern Michigan (1/13).

➤ **On The Shelf** – Sophomore defenseman **Chris Zarb (Waterford)** will be sidelined indefinitely after suffering an injury at Michigan State last Friday (2/9). Zarb is the team's top-scoring defenseman this season with a career-high 14 points (1-13=14) in 29 games and is a 2004 fifth-round draft pick of the Philadelphia Flyers. He generated 10 points (0-10=10) in 29 contests as a freshman last season.

➤ **Regular Season Home Finales** – Ferris State is 5-13-2 (.300) in its final two regular-season home outings since 1996-97. The Bulldogs went 0-1-1 in their last two regular-season home encounters a season ago, losing 3-2 to Notre Dame (2/11) and skating to a 3-3 overtime tie with Michigan (2/24). The last time Ferris faced Bowling Green to conclude the home portion of its regular season schedule was in the 1998-99 campaign (2/27/99) when the Bulldogs suffered a 6-4 loss to the Falcons in their home finale.

➤ **Miller Time** – Junior center **Adam Miller (Livonia)** recorded the game-winning goal in Tuesday's (1/13) win over Michigan State with a late third-period lamplighter. The goal was his third career game winner after recording two such tallies a season ago – at Denver (12/31) and at Western Michigan (2/3).

➤ **Best For Last** – Senior right wing **Zac Pearson (White Lake)** is one point shy of matching his career season-best 26 points (6-20=26) set in 40 games last season. Pearson has a current team-high 25 points (8-17=25) in 30 games this campaign. His eight goals are a career best, bettering his seven in 2004-05.

➤ **Senior Night** – The Bulldogs will honor their six seniors prior to this Saturday's (2/17) regular-season home finale. Forwards **Mark Bomersback, Zac Pearson, Matt Verdone, and Eric Vesely** along with defensemen **Jeremy Scherlinck and Joe Van Culin** will be recognized in a pre-game ceremony.

## HEAD COACH BOB DANIELS

Bob Daniels, the 2002-03 Spencer Penrose Award recipient as the American Hockey Coaches Association



(AHCA) Division I Coach of the Year and the all-time winningest coach in Ferris State hockey history, is currently in his 15th year at FSU. Under his guidance, the Bulldogs posted a school-record 31-10-1 overall record in 2002-03 while claiming their first-ever Central Collegiate Hockey Association (CCHA) Regular-Season Championship title with a first-

place 22-5-1 league mark.

For his efforts, Daniels was honored as the 2002-03 Coach of the Year by the CCHA, *Inside College Hockey* (INCH) and the March of Dimes West Michigan Sports Awards. Prior to the 2006-07 campaign, Daniels ranked 16th among active NCAA-I hockey coaches in overall victories and 29th in winning percentage.

Daniels became Ferris State's all-time winningest coach on March 4, 2000, when the Bulldogs posted a 7-0 regular-season finale victory at Western Michigan. In 1998-99, Daniels notched his 100th career coaching win as the Bulldogs skated to a 2-1 regular-season finale victory at Michigan State, which snapped both the Spartans' 23-game unbeaten streak and 27-game home unbeaten string. He posted his 200th victory with a 6-2 home triumph over Western Michigan on Dec. 4, 2004.

Daniels was appointed FSU's head coach on the eve of the 1992-93 season and in his first campaign, the Bulldogs registered 21 victories and earn a CCHA Tourney Semifinal berth. It signified only the fourth time a Ferris team had won 20 games in a season and the second time in which a rookie coach won more than 16 games at FSU.

An AHCA member, Daniels served a four-year term on the AHCA's Board of Governors and currently is a representative of the NCAA Tournament West Regional Selection Advisory Committee.

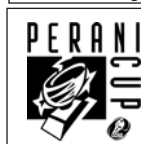
