GAMES 7-8 ▲ 2006-07 SEASON

THIS WEEKEND: The Ferris State University men's ice hockey team will make the trek to Fairbanks, Alaska, this weekend (Oct. 27-28) as the Bulldogs face the University of Alaska Nanooks in a two-game Central Collegiate Hockey Association (CCHA) series.

FACEOFF/ARENA: Friday & Saturday – 11:05 p.m. (EDT)/Carlson Center (4,595).

THE RECORDS: Ferris State is presently 3-3-0 overall and 1-1-0 in the CCHA as a result of splitting a league home-and-home series with Western Michigan last weekend (Oct. 20-21). The Bulldogs notched a 2-1 triumph in their CCHA opener last Friday (Oct. 20) at WMU's Lawson Ice Arena in Kalamazoo, Mich., before suffering a 5-3 loss in Saturday's (Oct. 21) finale at FSU's Ewigleben Ice Arena in Big Rapids, Mich.
 Last season, Ferris State compiled a 17-15-8 overall mark which included a sixth place-tying 10-11-7 CCHA record. The Bulldogs were 8-6-4 at home, 8-8-3 on the road and 1-1-1 at neutral sites for the 2005-06 campaign.

Alaska, formerly Alaska-Fairbanks, is currently 2-1-1 overall and 0-0-0 in the CCHA after going 0-1-1 last weekend (Oct. 20-21) in a non-league series versus Alaska-Anchorage at Fairbanks. The Nanooks dropped a 6-5 overtime decision to the Seawolves in the opener and then skated to a 1-1 overtime tie in the series finale. UA is listed among other teams receiving votes in the *U.S. College Hockey Online/College Sports Television (CSTV)* and *Inside College Hockey (INCH)* polls this week.

A season ago, Alaska posted an 18-16-5 overall record with an eighth-place tying 11-13-4 mark in the CCHA. The Nanooks were 8-5-3 at home

and 10-11-2 on the road in the 2005-06 season.

THE COACHES: Ferris State – **Bob Daniels** (Michigan State, 1982), 15th season, 228-267-48 (.464) – (19-17-2 vs. Alaska – 8-14-1 Away, 11-3-1 Home, 0-0-0 Neutral). **Alaska** – **Tavis MacMillan** (Alaska Fairbanks, 1994), 3rd season, 37-33-10 (.525) – (3-0-1 vs. Ferris State).

ABOUT ALASKA: The Nanooks are paced in scoring by junior left wing Kyle Greentree (3-4=7) and freshman center Dion Knelsen (4-3=7). Senior center Curtis Fraser (3-2=5), sophomore right wing Adam Naglich (2-3=5) and sophomore defenseman Tyler Eckford (2-3=5) are other UA scoring leaders. In goal are sophomore Chad Johnson (1-0-1, 0.48 GAA, .975sv%) and junior Wylie Rogers (1-1-0, 4.85 GAA, .859sv%). The Nanooks rank ninth nationally in scoring offense (4.25 avg.) and tied for 20th in scoring defense (2.75). Johnson leads the nation in save percentage and goals-against average. Eckford ranks tied for 10th place in points per game among defensemen (1.25 avg.) while Knelsen is tied for second in rookie scoring with a 1.75 average.

SERIES NOTES

- ◆ Ferris State and Alaska will square off for the 43rd and 44th times this weekend in a series which began in the 1984-85 season. Ferris presently has a 23-17-2 series lead.
- ◆ **OVERTIME** -- Ferris has a 2-2-2 record in such contests against Alaska. The Bulldogs registered a 5-4 win at the RPI Tournament (11/29/86), a 5-4 setback on the road (1/14/94), a 5-4 loss at home (1/12/96), and skated to a 4-4 overtime tie (2/22/97). FSU won 5-4 at UAF (12/14/97) and tied the Nanooks at 3-3 last season (11/5/05).
- ◆ **SHUTOUTS** -- Three shutouts in the series have occurred with Ferris accounting for two of them -- 8-0 win (1/12/85) in Big Rapids and a 5-0 triumph (11/1/02) at Fairbanks.
- ◆ **THE SITE** -- FSU is 8-14-1 on the road, 13-3-1 at home, and 2-0-0 at neutral sites versus the Nanooks.
- ◆ **BOB DANIELS vs. Alaska** -- 19-17-2 overall (11-3-1 at home and 8-14-1 on the road).

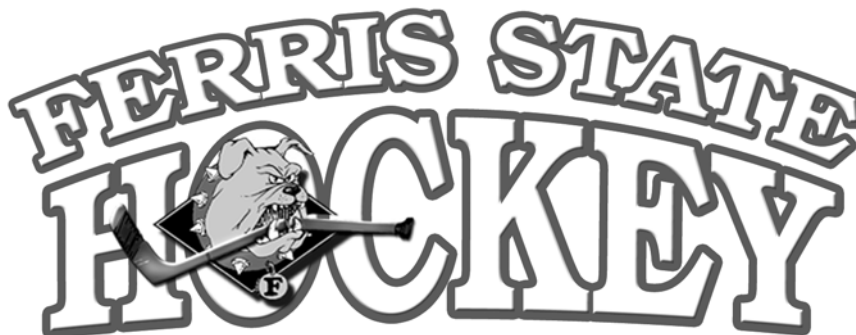
SERIES NOTES -- Nine of the last 19 meetings has been decided by three goals or more, including five of the last nine contests to date. In those nine games, the Bulldogs are 5-4-0 (.556).

◆ The Bulldogs are 1-6-1 (.188) in their last eight games versus Alaska after going 13-3-0 (.813) in the previous 16 encounters. FSU is 6-7-0 (.462) in its last 13 road contests at Fairbanks.

◆ Ferris State is 13-4-0 (.765) in games decided by three goals or more -- 3-2-0 on the road and 10-2-0 at home.

◆ The Bulldogs are 10-14-2 (.423) in contests decided by two goals or less -- 5-12-1 on the road, 3-2-1 at home, and 2-0-0 at neutral sites.
