GAMES 27-28 ▲ 2007-08 SEASON

THIS WEEKEND: The Ferris State University men's ice hockey team will wrap up its four-game Central Collegiate Hockey Association (CCHA) road swing this weekend (Feb. 8-9) as the Bulldogs visit the nationally-ranked University of Notre Dame Fighting Irish for a two-game series in Notre Dame, Ind.

FACEOFF/ARENA: Friday – 7:35 p.m. (EST) & Saturday – 7:05 p.m. (EST)/Joyce Center (2,713).

THE BROADCAST: All of Ferris State's 2007-08 CCHA games will be carried live by local radio station **Big Country WWBR-100.9 FM** with **Bill Beckwith** calling the action. The contests can be accessed live via the internet by clicking on the Bulldog Athletics Webcasts icon at www.ferris.edu/sports. **THE TELECAST:** This Friday's (Feb. 8) game will be televised live by Comcast Local with **Ben Holden** calling the action and **Sean Ritchin** providing analysis.

THE RECORDS: Ferris State is 10-12-4 overall and 7-10-3 in the CCHA to date after the Bulldogs went 0-1-1 in a two-game league set against Lake Superior State last weekend (Feb. 1-2) at LSSU's Taffy Abel Arena in Sault Ste. Marie, Mich. The Bulldogs are midst a five-game non-winning streak after going 3-1-1 in their previous five outings. Ferris State is currently 5-6-1 on the road and 4-6-3 at home this campaign.

◆ Ferris State compiled a 14-22-3 overall record a season ago, which included a ninth-place 10-16-2 CCHA mark.

Notre Dame, which is currently 20-9-1 overall and 13-6-1 in the CCHA, posted a 2-1 overtime exhibition win over the U.S. Under-18 Team last Friday (Feb. 1) at the UND's Joyce Center in Notre Dame, Ind. Prior to that tilt, the Fighting Irish swept a home-and-home league series against Bowling Green State two weeks ago (Jan. 25-26). UND claimed a 6-1 home win in the series opener (Jan. 25) and then recorded a 4-1 victory in the finale (Jan. 26) at the BGSU Ice Arena in Bowling Green, Ohio. The Irish, who are 8-1-1 at home this season, are ranked eighth this week in all three major college hockey polls – *Inside College Hockey.com* (INCH), *U.S. College Hockey Online/CSTV*, and *USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine*.

◆ A season ago, Notre Dame posted a 32-7-3 overall record with a first-place 21-4-3 CCHA mark. The Irish claimed their first-ever CCHA regular-season and tournament championship titles along with making their second NCAA Tournament appearance in the program's history.

THE COACHES: Ferris State – **Bob Daniels** (Michigan State, 1982), 16th season, 249-298-55

(.459) – (24-16-4 vs. Notre Dame – 15-10-3 Away, 7-6-1 Home, 2-0-0 Neutral). **Notre Dame – Jeff Jackson** (Michigan State, 1978), 3rd season, 65-35-8 (.639); Career: 9th season, 247-87-33 (.718) – (4-2-0 vs. Ferris State). Jackson, who was named the 2007 Spencer Penrose Award recipient as the national coach of the year, was 17-1-3 against Ferris State in his six seasons (1990-96) as head coach at Lake Superior State.

ABOUT NOTRE DAME: The Irish, who have 11 skaters with double-digit points totals, are led by junior right wing Erik Condra (11-19=30), senior center Mark Van Guilder (9-12=21), and sophomore right wing Ryan Thang (14-6=20). Condra is tied for 40th among the national leaders in points per game (1.00 avg.) while Thang is 38th in goals per game (0.47 avg.). Junior goaltender Jordan Pearce (16-8-1, 1.93 GAA, .915sv%), is listed eighth nationally in goals-against average and 31st in save percentage. ND is fourth nationally in both scoring defense (2.00 avg.) and penalty killing (89.9%), sixth in scoring margin (1.17), 11th in scoring offense (3.17 avg.), and 27th on the power play (15.8%).

☛ Ferris State is 5-4-1 (.550) in its last 10 appearances at Notre Dame. The Bulldogs are averaging 2.90 goals per outing (29 total) during the 10-game span while the Irish have averaged 2.70 goals an outing (27 total) for a +0.20 goals differential.

☛ Eight of the last 10 contests at Notre Dame have been decided by two goals or more with the Bulldogs generating a 4-4-0 mark (.500) in those encounters.

☛ Sixteen of the last 26 meetings between the two teams has been determined by two goals or less. Ferris State has produced a 7-7-2 (.500) record in those 16 contests.

SERIES NOTES

- ▲ Ferris State and Notre Dame will meet for the 59th and 60th times this weekend in a series which started in the 1981-82 season. The Bulldogs are 35-18-5 in their all-time series versus the Fighting Irish.
- ▲ **OVERTIME** -- Ferris has a 2-1-5 record in such contests against Notre Dame.
- ▲ **SHUTOUTS** -- Four shutouts in the series with FSU gaining three victories. Ferris recorded a 3-0 road win in the initial series meeting (11/27/81) before being dealt a 6-0 setback at home later in the 1981-82 campaign (2/13/82). The Bulldogs claimed a 1-0 win at ND (2/13/99) and notched a 3-0 home triumph this season (10/27/07).
- ▲ **THE SITE** -- FSU is 20-10-3 on the road, 13-8-2 at home, and 2-0-0 at neutral sites against Notre Dame.
- ▲ **Bob Daniels vs. NOTRE DAME** – 24-16-4 overall (15-10-3 road, 7-6-1 home, and 2-0-0 neutral sites).

SERIES NOTES – ☛ FSU is 16-11-5 (.578) versus Notre Dame in contests decided by two goals or less – 7-5-2 at home, 7-6-3 on the road, and 2-0-0 at neutral sites.

☛ The Bulldogs are 16-10-0 (.615) against Notre Dame in games decided by three goals or more – 10-7-0 on the road and 6-3-0 at home.

☛ Ferris State is 14-8-2 (.625) in its last 24 meetings against Notre Dame, which includes a 9-6-1 mark on the road, 3-2-1 at home, and 2-0-0 at neutral sites.
