GAMES 29-30 ▲ 2007-08 SEASON

THIS WEEKEND: The Ferris State University men's ice hockey team will go up against a nationally-ranked Central Collegiate Hockey Association (CCHA) opponent for the second consecutive week as the Bulldogs host the Miami University RedHawks this weekend (Feb. 15-16) in a two-game series at Big Rapids, Mich.

FACEOFF/ARENA: Friday & Saturday – 7:05 p.m. (EST)/Ewingleben Ice Arena (*pronounced A-VAH-glave-in*) (2,493).

THE BROADCAST: All of Ferris State's 2007-08 CCHA games will be carried live by local radio station **Big Country WWBR-100.9 FM** with **Bill Beckwith** calling the action. The contests can be accessed live via the internet by clicking on the Bulldog Athletics Webcasts icon at www.ferris.edu/sports. **VIDEO WEBCASTS:** A live video and audio webcast is available for all 2007-08 Ferris State home hockey games through B2Networks for a charge of \$6 per contest. Just click on the B2Networks icon which is located at www.ferris.edu/sports to access. **TICKET INFORMATION:** Tickets for all 2007-08 Bulldog home hockey games can be purchased by contacting the FSU Athletics Ticket Office at (231) 591-2888.

THE RECORDS: Ferris State is 11-12-5 overall and 8-10-4 in the CCHA after producing a 1-0-1 mark against then nationally eighth-ranked Notre Dame last weekend (Feb. 8-9) at UND's Joyce Center in Notre Dame, Ind. The Bulldogs are 1-3-3 in their last seven encounters to date. Ferris State is sports a 4-6-3 home mark and is 6-6-2 on the road this campaign.

☛ Ferris State compiled a 14-22-3 overall record a season ago, which included a ninth-place 10-16-2 CCHA mark.

Miami (Ohio) is 25-4-1 overall and 17-4-1 in CCHA play to date as a result of producing a 0-1-1 league home mark versus nationally-ranked Michigan last weekend (Feb. 8-9) at MU's Steve Cady Arena in Oxford, Ohio. The RedHawks suffered a 4-2 loss to the Wolverines last Friday (Feb. 8) to end their seven-game winning streak and then notched a come-from-behind 5-5 overtime tie against Michigan in last Saturday's (Feb. 9) weekend series finale. Miami, which is 13-1-0 in away outings this season, are ranked second in the nation this week in all three major college hockey polls – *Inside College Hockey.com (INCH)*, *U.S. College Hockey Online/CSTV*, and *USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine*.

☛ Miami (Ohio) registered a 24-14-4 overall

record and a third-place 16-8-4 CCHA mark for the 2006-07 season. The RedHawks competed in the NCAA Tournament for the third time in the last four years a season ago and achieved their first-ever win in the tourney with a 2-1 first-round triumph over New Hampshire.

THE COACHES: Ferris State – **Bob Daniels** (Michigan State, 1982), 16th season, 250-298-56 (.460) – (13-25-6 vs. Miami – 7-11-3 Home, 6-14-2 Away, 0-1-0 Neutral). **Miami (Ohio) – Enrico Blasi** (Miami, 1994), 9th season, 179-134-28 (.566) – (13-5-2 vs. Ferris State). Blasi was the recipient of the 2006 Spencer Penrose Award as the AHCA's Division I National Hockey Coach of the Year and is a three-time winner of the CCHA's Coach of the Year.

ABOUT MIAMI (OHIO): Senior forward Ryan Jones (24-13=37), who ranks fourth nationally in goals per game (0.80 avg.), leads 12 RedHawk skaters with double-figure points totals. Freshman forward Carter Camper (13-20=33) and junior forward Justin Mercier (20-11=31) are also among the top points leaders. Jones is 15th nationally in points per game (1.23) while Camper is 16th (1.22). Junior goaltender Jeff Zatkoff (20-4-1, 1.74 GAA, .929sv%) is second among the nation's leaders in goals-against average and fifth in save percentage. Miami is first nationally in scoring offense (4.33) and scoring defense (1.73).

GAMES THIS WEEK

➤ **30th Anniversary** – The 2007-08 season represents the 30th anniversary for the Ferris State men's ice hockey program competing at the NCAA Division I level. The Bulldogs registered a 10-24-0 overall record in the 1978-79 season which marked their NCAA Division I debut.

➤ **What Lies Ahead** – The Bulldogs' remaining six regular-season games are against opponents with a combined league record of 44-17-5 (.705) with all three teams currently ahead of them in the CCHA standings. Three of those final final six contests are on the road.

➤ **Congrats!** – Ferris State head coach **Bob Daniels** earned his 250th career coaching win with last Friday's (2/8) 5-3 victory at Notre Dame. Daniels, who's the sixth head coach in FSU's history, is the program's all-time winningest coach.

➤ **Close Encounters** – Five of the last six Ferris State contests have been determined by one goal or less with the Bulldogs compiling a 0-2-3 (.300) mark in those outings. FSU has been involved in 13 one goal or less games this season and is 3-5-5 (.423) in such contests.

➤ **Getting Close** – Ferris State is three victories away from matching last season's 14-win total (14-22-3 overall) as the Bulldogs' current 11 victories this season (11-12-5) marks the 30th consecutive year in which the program has won at least 10 games per campaign.

➤ **Just About There** – The Bulldogs, who have totaled 20 league points (8-10-4 CCHA mark) in 22 CCHA tilts this season, are two shy of matching last season's 22 points output (10-16-2 CCHA).

➤ **Streak Ends** – Ferris State had outshot its opponent in the last 11 games before having its streak snapped as Notre Dame outshots the Bulldogs 35-to-29 in last Saturday's (2/9) contest. FSU is averaging 36.7 shots on goal (440 total) per outing during that span.

➤ **Lending A Helping Hand** – Junior goaltender **Mitch O'Keefe (Almonte, Ontario)** notched his fourth assist of this season with a helper at Notre Dame (2/8). O'Keefe has recorded an assist this campaign on three prior occasions – at Ohio State (11/4), vs. Michigan State (12/7), and vs. Western Michigan (1/26).

➤ **Moving Up The Chart** – **Mitch O'Keefe** moved into a tie for ninth place among Ferris' all-time victories leaders by notching his 27th career win with last Friday's triumph at Notre Dame. O'Keefe, who has amassed a 27-36-15 career mark in 79 appearances, is presently tied with current Miami assistant coach Jeff Blashill (1994-98) for ninth. O'Keefe, the 2005-06 FSU Rookie of the Year, is now one win shy from tying Ted Ykema (1978-81) and Pat Mazzoli (1990-93) for seventh place. O'Keefe is already the school's record holder for most career ties with 15 total.

➤ **Miller Time** – Senior center **Adam Miller (Livonia)** has produced six points (2-4=6) in his last eight outings and has recorded at least a point in six of those contests. Miller, who recorded a helper in last Friday's (2/8) game at Notre Dame, has racked up 17 points (5-12=17) in 28 games this season after generating 15 points (9-6=15) in 31 outings in the 2006-07 campaign. Miller is five points shy of matching his career single-season best 22 points (10-12=22) set in 40 games as a sophomore (2005-06 season). He garnered a month-best eight points (6-2=8) in as many games last February.

➤ **Another Contributor** – Freshman right wing **Todd Pockocke (Saginaw)** became the 20th skater on the team to record a lampighter as he produced the game winner in last Friday's (2/8) contest on his first collegiate tally. Ferris' rookie class has accounted for 27.0% (20-74) of the squad's goal-scoring production this campaign as all but one of the seven freshmen has netted a marker.

➤ **Impressive Short Game** – The Bulldogs have totaled six short-handed goals in 28 games this season while limiting the opposition to one shorthie. A season ago at this time, FSU had tallied two short-handed markers while its opponent had generated seven total in penalty-kill situations.

HEAD COACH BOB DANIELS

Bob Daniels, the 2002-03 Spencer Penrose Award recipient as the American Hockey Coaches Association



(AHCA) Division I Coach of the Year and the all-time winningest coach in Ferris State hockey history, is currently in his 16th year at FSU. Under his guidance, the Bulldogs posted a school-record 31-10-1 overall record in 2002-03 while claiming their first-ever Central Collegiate Hockey Association (CCHA) Regular-Season Championship title with a first-

place 22-5-1 league mark.

For his efforts, Daniels was honored as the 2002-03 Coach of the Year by the CCHA, *Inside College Hockey* (INCH) and the March of Dimes West Michigan Sports Awards. Prior to the 2006-08 campaign, Daniels ranked 16th among active NCAA-I hockey coaches in overall victories.

Daniels became Ferris State's all-time winningest coach on March 4, 2000, when the Bulldogs posted a 7-0 regular-season finale victory at Western Michigan. In 1998-99, Daniels notched his 100th career coaching win as the Bulldogs skated to a 2-1 regular-season finale victory at Michigan State, which snapped both the Spartans' 23-game unbeaten streak and 27-game home unbeaten string. He posted his 200th victory with a 6-2 home triumph over Western Michigan on Dec. 4, 2004.

Daniels was appointed FSU's head coach on the eve of the 1992-93 season and in his first campaign, the Bulldogs registered 21 victories and earn a CCHA Tourney Semifinal berth. It signified only the fourth time a Ferris team had won 20 games in a season and the second time in which a rookie coach won more than 16 games at FSU.

An AHCA member, Daniels served a four-year term on the AHCA's Board of Governors and currently is a representative of the NCAA Tournament West Regional Selection Advisory Committee.
