GAMES 31-32 ▲ 2007-08 SEASON

THIS WEEKEND: The nationally-ranked Ferris State University men's ice hockey team will seek to extend its current five-game unbeaten streak this weekend (Feb. 22-23) as the Bulldogs skate against the Bowling Green State University Falcons in a two-game Central Collegiate Hockey Association (CCHA) series at Bowling Green, Ohio.

FACEOFF/ARENA: Friday & Saturday – 7:05 p.m. (EST)/BGSU Ice Arena (5,000).

THE BROADCAST: All of Ferris State's 2007-08 CCHA games will be carried live by local radio station **Big Country WWBR-100.9 FM** with **Bill Beckwith** calling the action. The contests can be accessed live via the internet by clicking on the Bulldog Athletics Webcasts icon at **www.ferris.edu/sports**. **TICKET INFORMATION:** Tickets for all 2007-08 Bulldog home hockey games can be purchased by contacting the FSU Athletics Ticket Office at (231) 591-2888.

THE RECORDS: Ferris State, which is ranked 19th nationally in this week's (Feb. 17) *Inside College Hockey.com's (INCH)* poll, improved to 13-12-5 overall and 10-10-4 in the CCHA with a two-game league home sweep of nationally second-ranked Miami (Ohio) last weekend (Feb. 15-16) at FSU's Ewigleben Ice Arena in Big Rapids, Mich. The Bulldogs extended their current unbeaten streak to a season-best five games (3-0-2) with the two league wins. Ferris State is 6-6-2 on the road, 6-6-3 at home, and 1-0-0 at neutral sites this campaign. The Bulldogs are listed among other teams receiving votes in this week's *U.S. College Hockey Online/CSTV* poll.

➤ Ferris State compiled a 14-22-3 overall record a season ago, which included a ninth-place 10-16-2 CCHA mark.

Bowling Green State is 15-15-0 overall and 12-12-0 in the CCHA to date following a two-game league series split against Nebraska-Omaha last weekend (Feb. 15-16) at the Civic Auditorium in Omaha, Neb. The Falcons, who are listed among other teams receiving votes in this week's *U.S. College Hockey Online/CSTV* poll, are 5-5-0 in their last 10 contests. BGSU is 6-6-0 at home, 9-8-0 on the road, and 0-1-0 at neutral sites this campaign.

➤ Bowling Green State finished the 2006-07 campaign at 7-29-2 overall with a 12th-place 5-22-1 CCHA mark.

(Michigan State, 1982), 16th season, 252-298-56 (.462) – (22-17-6 vs. Bowling Green State – 9-10-3 Away, 13-7-3 Home, 0-0-0 Neutral). **Bowling Green State – Scott Paluch** (Bowling Green State, 1991), 6th season, 70-126-20 (.370) – (3-9-2 vs. Ferris State). Paluch earned 1987-88 All-America and All-CCHA First-Team honors as a senior at BGSU. He served as an associate head coach at Boston College from 1995-02 prior to becoming the fifth coach in the program's history.

ABOUT BOWLING GREEN STATE: The Falcons currently have 12 skaters with double-digit points totals, led by senior forward Derek Whitmore (26-6=32) and freshman forward Jacob Cepis (12-15=27). Whitmore leads the nation in goals per game (0.90 gpg.) and is 23rd in points per game (1.10 ppg.) among the national leaders. Freshman goaltender Nick Eno (10-6-0, 2.57 GAA, .912sv%) and junior netminder Jimmy Spratt (5-9-0, 2.96 GAA, .889sv%) have shared the netminding duties this season.

GAMES THIS WEEK

- **30th Anniversary** – The 2007-08 season represents the 30th anniversary for the Ferris State men's ice hockey program competing at the NCAA Division I level. The Bulldogs registered a 10-24-0 overall record in the 1978-79 season which marked their NCAA Division I debut.
- **Better Than A Season Ago** – Ferris State's 24 league points (10-10-4 CCHA) in 24 games this season already exceeds last season's 22 league points (10-16-2) in 28 league encounters. The Bulldogs are three point shy of equalling the 2005-06 team's sixth-place tying 27 league points total (10-11-7).
- **Just One More** – The Bulldogs are one victory away from matching last season's 14-win total (14-22-3 overall) as FSU's current 13 victories this season (13-12-5 overall) marks the 30th consecutive year in which the program has won at least 10 games per campaign.
- **Unbeaten Streak** – FSU's present five-game (3-0-2) unbeaten streak represents a season best. The Bulldogs are averaging 3.4 goals per game (17 total) during the span while the opposition has averaged 2.4 goals an outing (12 total). Sophomore left wing **Blair Riley (Kamloops, British Columbia)** has compiled a squad-high six points (3-3=6) in those five games.
- **Moving Up The Charts** – Junior goaltender **Mitch O'Keefe (Almonte, Ontario)** moved into a tie for seventh place among Ferris' all-time victories leaders with last Friday's (2/15) 6-5 victory over Miami by registering his 28th career win. O'Keefe, who has amassed a 28-36-15 career mark in 80 appearances, is presently tied with Ted Ykema (1978-81) and Pat Mazzoli (1990-93) for seventh place. He's two victories away from moving into a fifth-place tie with Mike Williams (1986-90) and Craig Lisko (1990-94). O'Keefe is the school's record holder for most career ties with 15 total.
- **Wietecha Earns CCHA Weekly Honor** – Freshman defenseman **Scott Wietecha (Wolverine Lake)** has been named this week's CCHA Defenseman of the Week for his performance in last weekend's (2/15-16) two-game league series sweep of nationally-ranked Miami (Ohio). Wietecha tallied the game-winning goal in Saturday's (2/16) 3-1 win with a late third-period tally and notched the first assist on the Bulldogs' game-winning lamplighter in Friday's (2/15) 6-5 victory over the RedHawks. Wietecha is the fourth FSU skater to garner weekly league honors this campaign.
- **Give It Up For Chupp** – Sophomore right wing **Cody Chupp (Big Rapids)** picked up his team-leading 23rd point (8-15=23) this season with an empty-net tally against Miami last Saturday (2/16). His double-digit points total this campaign in 30 contests matches his 2006-07 season output of 23 points (8-15=23) in 37 outings. Chupp, who has five points (3-2=5) in his last four games, is four points (16-30=46) away from notching his 50th career point.
- **Out For The Season** – Senior defenseman **Adam Welch (Hastings, Minn.)** will miss the remainder of the 2007-08 season as a result of a knee injury suffered in a weekend league series finale tilt at Lake Superior State (2/2). Welch, a three-time FSU captain, had generated two points (0-2=2) this season in 25 contests.
- **Life of Riley** – **Blair Riley** has accumulated a combined 10 points (5-5=10) in his last 10 appearances, highlighted by a season-best tying three-point (1-2=3) game against Miami (2/15).
- **Goal Scorer** – Junior right wing **Justin Lewandowski (Naperville, Ill.)** has recorded seven of his eight points (7-1=8) this season on goals. Lewandowski, who has three points (2-1=3) in his last four games, netted a goal last Friday versus Miami and then claimed his first assist of this season in Saturday's game.
- **Did You Know?** – Ferris' 83 goals this season in its initial 30 games is identical to last season's production following the first 30 contests. Defensively, FSU has allowed 72 goals this season compared to 106 lamplighters in the 2006-07 campaign for a 34-goals difference.

HEAD COACH BOB DANIELS

Bob Daniels, the 2002-03 Spencer Penrose Award recipient as the American Hockey Coaches Association



(AHCA) Division I Coach of the Year and the all-time winningest coach in Ferris State hockey history, is currently in his 16th year at FSU. Under his guidance, the Bulldogs posted a school-record 31-10-1 overall record in 2002-03 while claiming their first-ever Central Collegiate Hockey Association (CCHA) Regular-Season Championship title with a first-

place 22-5-1 league mark.

For his efforts, Daniels was honored as the 2002-03 Coach of the Year by the CCHA, *Inside College Hockey* (INCH) and the March of Dimes West Michigan Sports Awards. Prior to the 2006-08 campaign, Daniels ranked 16th among active NCAA-I hockey coaches in overall victories.

Daniels became Ferris State's all-time winningest coach on March 4, 2000, when the Bulldogs posted a 7-0 regular-season finale victory at Western Michigan. In 1998-99, Daniels notched his 100th career coaching win as the Bulldogs skated to a 2-1 regular-season finale victory at Michigan State, which snapped both the Spartans' 23-game unbeaten streak and 27-game home unbeaten string. He posted his 200th victory with a 6-2 home triumph over Western Michigan on Dec. 4, 2004 and 250th win on Feb. 8 in a 5-3 decision at Notre Dame.

Daniels was appointed FSU's head coach on the eve of the 1992-93 season and in his first campaign, the Bulldogs registered 21 victories and a earn a CCHA Tourney Semifinal berth. It signified only the fourth time a Ferris team had won 20 games in a season and the second time in which a rookie coach won more than 16 games at FSU.

An AHCA member, Daniels served a four-year term on the AHCA's Board of Governors and currently is a representative of the NCAA Tournament West Regional Selection Advisory Committee.
