## GAME 15-16 ▲ 2007-08 SEASON

**THIS WEEKEND:** The Ferris State University men's ice hockey team will play a Central Collegiate Hockey Association (CCHA) home-and-home series for the second straight week as the Bulldogs face the nationally-ranked Michigan State University Spartans this weekend (Dec. 7-8) in a two-game set. FSU hosts the Spartans this Friday (Dec. 7) in Big Rapids, Mich., before traveling to East Lansing, Mich., this Saturday (Dec. 8) for the series finale. This Saturday's contest will be televised live on Comcast Local.

**FACEOFF/ARENA:** Friday – 7:05 p.m. (EST)/Ewingleben Ice Arena (*pronounced A-VAH-glave-in*) (2,493) & Saturday – 7:05 p.m. (EST)/Munn Ice Arena (6,470).

**THE BROADCAST:** All of Ferris State's 2007-08 CCHA games will be carried live by local radio station **Big Country WWBR-100.9 FM** with **Bill Beckwith** calling the action. The contests can be accessed live via the internet by clicking on the Bulldog Athletics Webcasts icon at [www.ferris.edu/sports](http://www.ferris.edu/sports). **VIDEO WEBCASTS:** A live video and audio webcast is available for all 2007-08 Ferris State home hockey games through B2Networks for a charge of \$6 per contest. **THE RECORDS:** Ferris State improved to 7-6-1 overall and 6-4-0 in the CCHA with a two-game CCHA home-and-home series sweep of Western Michigan last weekend (Nov. 30-Dec. 1). Ferris posted a 4-0 home win last Friday (Nov. 30) at FSU's Ewingleben Ice Arena and notched a 3-2 triumph over the Broncos Saturday (Dec. 1) at WMU's Lawson Ice Arena in Kalamazoo, Mich. Ferris State, which is 6-3-0 in its last nine games, is among other teams receiving votes this week in the *U.S. College Hockey Online/CSTV* and *Inside College Hockey.com (INCH)* national polls. The Bulldogs are 3-3-1 at home and 4-3-0 on the road this campaign.

☛ Ferris State compiled a 14-22-3 overall record a season ago, which included a ninth-place 10-16-2 CCHA mark.

**Michigan State** is 10-3-2 overall and 6-2-0 in the CCHA after claiming a two-game CCHA road sweep of Lake Superior State last weekend (Nov. 30-Dec. 1) at LSSU's Taffy Abel Arena in Sault Ste. Marie, Mich. The Spartans skated to a 3-2 win in Friday's (Nov. 30) opener and then posted a 5-2 victory in Saturday's (Dec. 1) rematch. This week, MSU is currently ranked third by *Inside College Hockey.com (INCH)*, fourth by

*USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine* and fifth in the *U.S. College Hockey Online/CSTV* poll.

☛ A season ago, the Spartans claimed the 2006-07 NCAA Division I National Championship by posting a 3-1 win over Boston College in the title game. MSU finished 26-13-3 overall with a fourth-place 15-10-3 league mark.

**THE COACHES:** Ferris State – **Bob Daniels** (Michigan State, 1982), 16th season, 246-292-52 (.460) – (10-31-7 vs. Michigan State – 2-12-5 Home, 7-18-1 Away, 1-1-1 Neutral). **Michigan State** – **Rick Comley** (Lake Superior State, 1972), 6th season, 127-76-21 (.614); Career: 35th season, 724-551-92 (.563) – (7-3-2 vs. Ferris State at MSU and 44-16-4 vs. FSU in career). Comley, who spent 26 seasons (1976-2002) as the first head coach at Northern Michigan, is just one of three head coaches to win NCAA titles at two different institutions and is among the top five coaches all-time in collegiate victories.

**ABOUT MICHIGAN STATE:** MSU has eight skaters with double-digit points totals, led by junior forward Tim Kennedy (12-6=18) along with senior forward Bryan Lerg (8-6=14) and junior forward Matt Schepke (7-7=14). Junior Jeff Lerg (9-3-2, 2.55 GAA, .906sv%) has been the primary goaltender this season. MSU ranks seventh nationally in scoring offense (3.47 gpg.).

## HEAD COACH BOB DANIELS

Bob Daniels, the 2002-03 Spencer Penrose Award recipient as the American Hockey Coaches Association



(AHCA) Division I Coach of the Year and the all-time winningest coach in Ferris State hockey history, is currently in his 16th year at FSU. Under his guidance, the Bulldogs posted a school-record 31-10-1 overall record in 2002-03 while claiming their first-ever Central Collegiate Hockey Association (CCHA) Regular-Season Championship title with a first-

place 22-5-1 league mark.

For his efforts, Daniels was honored as the 2002-03 Coach of the Year by the CCHA, *Inside College Hockey* (INCH) and the March of Dimes West Michigan Sports Awards. Prior to the 2006-08 campaign, Daniels ranked 16th among active NCAA-I hockey coaches in overall victories.

Daniels became Ferris State's all-time winningest coach on March 4, 2000, when the Bulldogs posted a 7-0 regular-season finale victory at Western Michigan. In 1998-99, Daniels notched his 100th career coaching win as the Bulldogs skated to a 2-1 regular-season finale victory at Michigan State, which snapped both the Spartans' 23-game unbeaten streak and 27-game home unbeaten string. He posted his 200th victory with a 6-2 home triumph over Western Michigan on Dec. 4, 2004.

Daniels was appointed FSU's head coach on the eve of the 1992-93 season and in his first campaign, the Bulldogs registered 21 victories and earn a CCHA Tourney Semifinal berth. It signified only the fourth time a Ferris team had won 20 games in a season and the second time in which a rookie coach won more than 16 games at FSU.

An AHCA member, Daniels served a four-year term on the AHCA's Board of Governors and currently is a representative of the NCAA Tournament West Regional Selection Advisory Committee.

➤ **30th Anniversary** – The 2007-08 season represents the 30th anniversary for the Ferris State men's ice hockey program competing at the NCAA Division I level. The Bulldogs registered a 10-24-0 overall record in the 1978-79 season which marked their NCAA Division I debut.

➤ **Case Picks Up CCHA Honor** – Junior defenseman **Evan Case (Grosse Pointe Woods)** was named this week's (12/3) CCHA Defenseman of the Week for his performance in last weekend's (11/30-12/1) league home-and-home series sweep of Western Michigan. Case tallied his first two goals of this season in Friday's (11/30) win to earn Perani Cup First Star of the Game honors. He then assisted on a marker and had a blocked shot in Saturday's (12/1) victory at WMU. Case, who received CCHA laurels for the first time in his career, is the second Bulldog to garner weekly league recognition as junior goaltender **Mitch O'Keefe (Almonte, Ontario)** was selected as the CCHA Goaltender of the Week earlier this season (10/29). Case's seven points (2-5=7) in 14 games is a career season best, eclipsing his four points (1-3=4) in 28 outings last season in which he earned FSU's Most Improved Player Award.

➤ **Marked Improvement** – The Bulldogs are 7-6-1 overall (3-3-0 away) through 14 games this season. A season ago at this time, Ferris State was 4-9-1 overall. FSU is 4-3-0 in away encounters this campaign compared to a 1-3-1 road ledger a season ago.

➤ **Shutout** – Ferris State's three shutouts to date this campaign represents the program's most since the historic 2002-03 season (31-10-1 overall record and CCHA Regular-Season Champions) when the Bulldogs held their opponent scoreless four times. All three FSU shutouts have occurred in CCHA play – Notre Dame (3-0, 10/27), at Ohio State (4-0, 11/2), and Western Michigan (4-0, 11/30).

➤ **Puck Stopper** – **Mitch O'Keefe (Almonte, Ontario)** racked up his fifth career shutout with last Friday's (11/30) 4-0 home win over Western Michigan. O'Keefe, the 2005-06 FSU Rookie of the Year, is one shutout away from moving into a second-place tie with Vince Owen (1997-01) and Phil Osaer (1998-01) on the program's all-time leaders list. O'Keefe presently ranks second on Ferris' all-time charts in goals-against average (2.74), third in save percentage (.900), sixth in minutes played (4,033), eighth in game played (69), ninth in saves (1,651), and tied for 10th in career wins (24).

➤ **A Comparison** – The Bulldogs hold a 38-29 advantage in goals scored during the team's initial 14 games this season, which includes a first-period 13-8 margin. Last season, Ferris had been outscored by a 46-37 margin.

➤ **Season's Best** – Junior right wing **Justin Lewandowski (Naperville, Ill.)** matches his career single-season points total with his fifth goal of the season at Western Michigan (12/1). Lewandowski, who currently has five points (5-0=5) in 13 outings this campaign, produced five points (1-4=5) in 17 2006-07 contests. Eight of his 14 career points in 55 games have been lamplighters.

➤ **Good Showing** – Ferris has outscored its opponent 12-5 in the last four games, which includes a 6-1 first-period scoring advantage. **Mitch O'Keefe** (1-1-0, 1.02 GAA, .961sv%) and freshman goaltender **Pat Nagle** (2-0-0, 1.50 GAA, .941sv%) have combined for a 1.25 goals-against average (five goals allowed) and a .951 save percentage (97 total saves) in those four games.

➤ **Ferris' Nominee** – Senior defenseman **Adam Welch (Hastings, Minn.)** has been nominated for the Lowe's Senior CLASS (Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying In School) Award. The award, is designed to honor the attributes of seniors who remain committed to their university and elect to pursue the many rewards that a senior season can bring. Welch is a three-year team captain and only the fourth skater in FSU history to serve in that capacity for more than two seasons.

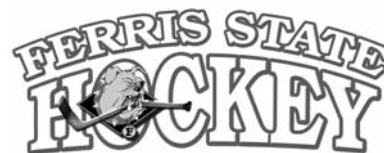
