GAMES 21-22 ▲ 2007-08 SEASON

THIS WEEKEND: The Ferris State University men's ice hockey team hosts the Northern Michigan University Wildcats this weekend (Jan. 18-19) in a two-game Central Collegiate Hockey Association (CCHA) series in Big Rapids, Mich. The two-game set marks the only regular-season encounters between the teams for the 2007-08 campaign.

FACEOFF/ARENA: Friday – 7:05 p.m. (EST) & Saturday – 8:07 p.m. (EST)/Ewigleben Ice Arena (*pronounced A-VAH-glave-in*) (2,493).

THE BROADCAST: All of Ferris State's 2007-08 CCHA games will be carried live by local radio station **Big Country WWBR-100.9 FM** with **Bill Beckwith** calling the action. The contests can be accessed live via the internet by clicking on the Bulldog Athletics Webcasts icon at www.ferris.edu/sports. **VIDEO WEBCASTS:** A live video and audio webcast is available for all 2007-08 Ferris State home hockey games through B2Networks for a charge of \$6 per contest. Just click on the B2Networks icon which is located at www.ferris.edu/sports to access.

THE TELECAST: This Saturday's (Jan. 19) game will be televised live by College Sports Television (CSTV) – DirecTV channel 610 and Dish Network channel 152). **Matt McConnell** will be calling the action with **Dave Starman** providing analysis. CSTV will be making its debut at FSU's Ewigleben Ice Arena.

THE RECORDS: Ferris State is currently 9-9-2 overall and 6-7-1 in the CCHA after compiling a 0-1-1 mark last weekend (Jan. 11-12) in a two-game league home set against the Alaska Nanooks in Big Rapids. The Bulldogs, who are 4-3-1 in their last eight outings to date, are listed this week among other teams receiving votes by *U.S. College Hockey Online/CSTV*.
 ● Ferris State compiled a 14-22-3 overall record a season ago, which included a ninth-place 10-16-2 CCHA mark.

Northern Michigan is 9-14-1 overall and 6-10-0 in the CCHA after suffering a pair of non-league losses to Wayne State last weekend (Jan. 11-12) at NMU's Berry Events Center in Marquette, Mich. The Wildcats dropped a 4-1 decision to the Warriors last Friday (Jan. 11) and then were dealt a 3-2 overtime setback in Saturday's (Jan. 12) finale to extend their current losing skid to three games. NMU is 8-6-1 in its last 15 contests to date while sporting a 5-5-0 road mark this campaign.

● Northern Michigan posted a 15-24-2 overall

record with a 10th-place 10-17-1 CCHA mark for the 2006-07 season.

THE COACHES: Ferris State – **Bob Daniels** (Michigan State, 1982), 16th season, 248-295-53 (.461) – (13-19-1 vs. Northern Michigan – 4-9-1 Home, 8-10-0 Away, 1-0-0 Neutral). **Northern Michigan** – **Walt Kyle** (Northern Michigan, 1981), 6th season, 111-98-18 (.529) – (9-4-0 vs. Ferris State). Kyle is the second head coach in NMU history and served as an assistant coach for the Wildcats from 1982-92. He was the program's top assistant in 1991 when NMU won the NCAA Division I national title.

ABOUT NORTHERN MICHIGAN: The Wildcats are led in scoring by junior forward Nick Sirota (12-10=22) and freshman forward Mark Olver (8-10=18), who are among seven NMU skaters with double-digit points totals. Sirota is tied for 31st nationally in goals per game (0.52 avg.) while Olver is 11th in points per game (0.95 avg.) among rookies. Sophomore forward Matt Butcher (4-10=14) and senior forward Matt Siddall (5-8=13) are also rank high on the Cats' scoring leaders list. Sophomore Brian Stewart (5-9-1, 2.94 GAA, .893sv%) has been NMU's primary goaltender this season while freshman Reid Ellington (4-4-0, 2.96 GAA, .893sv%) and sophomore Derek Janzen (0-1-0, 3.39 GAA, .848sv%) have also received action.

◆ Ferris State is 2-7-1 in its last 10 home encounters versus Northern Michigan as the Bulldogs are averaging 2.40 goals per game (24 total) to the Wildcats' 3.20 goals (32 total) an outing for a 0.80 goals margin.

SERIES NOTES

- ◆ Ferris State and Northern Michigan will meet for the 64th and 65th times this weekend in an all-time series which started in the 1976-77 season. Northern Michigan has a 44-17-2 all-time series lead to date and won the first 16 meetings between the two teams.
- ◆ **OVERTIME** -- Ferris State is 2-2-2 versus NMU -- 2-2-2 at home.
- ◆ **SHUTOUTS** -- Ferris State is 1-3-0 against Northern Michigan -- (1-2-0 on the road and 0-1-0 at home).
- ◆ **THE SITE** -- FSU is 7-17-2 at home, 9-26-0 on the road, and 1-1-0 at neutral sites versus the Wildcats.
- ◆ **BOB DANIELS vs. Northern Michigan** -- 13-19-1 overall (4-9-1 at home, 8-10-0 on the road, and 1-0-0 at neutral sites).

SERIES NOTES -- 19 of the last 26 meetings between the two teams have been decided by two goals or less. Ferris State is 6-12-1 (.342) in such contests -- 2-7-1 home, 3-5-0 away, and 1-0-0 neutral.

◆ FSU is 13-20-0 (.394) in games decided by three goals or more -- 8-9-0 away, 5-10-0 home, and 0-1-0 neutral.

◆ The Bulldogs are 13-21-2 (.394) in contests decided by two goals or less -- 6-10-2 home, 6-11-0 away, and 1-0-0 neutral.

◆ Seven of the last 11 meetings have been decided by two goals or less with Ferris State sporting a 3-4-0 record in those contests.
