BULLDOG HOCKEY FACILITIES

Being a member of the Central Collegiate Hockey Association (CCHA), regarded by many as college hockey's premiere league, requires a commitment to excellence and Ferris State University is adhering to the high-standard principle.

With that particular mindset, enhancements to FSU's Robert L. Ewigleben Ice Arena were made within the last four years to assist the program in recruiting top-quality student-athletes.

As part of the Ice Arena Remodeling Project, a spacious home for Bulldog hockey – the 4,560 gross-square-foot locker room annex was constructed on the Arena's west side and was officially dedicated January 17, 1999.

The state-of-the art locker room facility, financed through university funding and monies raised by the Bulldog Hockey Pride Committee, features a locker room with 30 individual lockers, two coaches' offices and a private dressing room, players' lounge, a stick room, equipment issue room, sauna, and a study lounge which has multiple computers with internet connections along with spacious rooms for sports medicine, film study and exercise bikes. A complete stereo sound system was installed throughout the entire locker room area.
