FERRIS STATE VISITS BOWLING GREEN IN MAKEUP CONTEST

THIS WEEK: The Ferris State University men's ice hockey team faces the Bowling Green State University Falcons this Monday (Jan. 16) evening in a Central Collegiate Hockey Association (CCHA) game at Bowling Green, Ohio.

FACEOFF/ARENA: Monday – 7:05 p.m. (EDT)/BGSU Ice Arena (5,000).

BROADCAST INFORMATION: All of Ferris State's 2005-06 league games will be carried live by local radio station **Big Country WWBR-100.9 FM** with **Bill Beckwith** calling the play-by-play. Those contests can also be accessed live via the internet by clicking on the Bulldog Athletics Webcasts icon at www.ferris.edu/sports. Live internet stats will also be available by going to the official CCHA website at <http://ccha.collegesports.com> and then click on Games/Results section near the league standings.

TICKET INFORMATION: Tickets for all 2005-06 Ferris State Hockey home games is available by contacting the Ewigleben (*pronounced A-VAH-glave-in*) Arena Ticket Office at (231) 591-2888. Hours are Monday thru Friday – 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. (ET) and Saturday (home games only) – 12 to 5 p.m. (ET).

GAME SUSPENDED: The Oct. 27 contest at Bowling Green State was suspended after a 0-0 tie through the opening period due to ice conditions. In between periods, a line was hit while drilling a hole for the nets. As coolant continued to come up through the ice the game had to be called for safety reasons. At this time the game has yet to be rescheduled and will be when a date and time are mutually agreed upon by both schools. The Falcons and Bulldogs both totaled nine shots apiece in the opening frame. When a time and date are determined the game will resume, starting in the second period, with Ferris State having 1:47 left on their power play. The last time an ice problem of this nature occurred was at the 1997 NCAA Division I Frozen Four National Championships.

THE RECORDS: Ferris State is currently 9-8-5 overall and is 4-6-4 in the CCHA after suffering a 2-1 league loss to Northern Michigan last Saturday (Jan. 14) at NMU's Berry Events Center in Marquette, Mich. Ferris dropped a 5-0 league decision to NMU in last Friday's (Jan. 13) league weekend series opener. The Bulldogs claimed third place at the 14th annual Wells Fargo Denver Cup (Dec. 20-31) in Denver, Colo., with a 3-2 victory over nationally-ranked and host Denver. FSU was ranked 19th this past week in both the *Inside College Hockey*

(*INCH*) and *U.S. College Hockey Online/College Sports Television (CSTV)* polls.

● Last season, Ferris State was 13-22-4 overall with a 10th place-tying 7-17-4 CCHA mark. The Bulldogs were 4-12-2 at home, 8-10-2 on the road and 1-0-0 at neutral sites.

Bowling Green State improved to 11-12-1 overall and 7-9-1 in the CCHA this season with a 5-2 league win over Western Michigan last Saturday (Jan. 14) at the BGSU Ice Arena in Bowling Green, Ohio. The Falcons, who are 8-7-0 at home this campaign, had their six-game winning streak snapped last Friday (Jan. 13) with a 5-4 loss to WMU.

● A season ago, Bowling Green State finished 16-16-4 overall with a fifth-place 13-12-3 league mark.

➤ **Nearing The Century Mark** – Senior center-right wing **Greg Rallo (Gurnee, Ill.)** is six points away from attaining his 100th career point. Rallo has totaled 94 career points (41-53-94) in 134 contests to date.

➤ **Muzzled** – Prior to last Friday night's 5-0 loss at Northern Michigan, the last time Ferris State was held scoreless was last season (10/29/04) in a 3-0 setback at Michigan. The Bulldogs went 52 consecutive games with a least a goal before last night's result.

➤ **Lone Sniper** – Freshman right wing **Corey Couturier (Traverse City)** accounted for FSU's lone goal in the Northern Michigan series with a first-period lamplighter in Saturday's contest. Four of his last five points have occurred on goals, including his last two – vs. Boston College (12/30) and at Northern Michigan (1/14).

➤ **So Far, So Good** – Ferris State's 12 league points in 14 CCHA games this season is six shy of matching its entire 18 points league total (7-17-4 record) for the 2004-05 campaign.

➤ **January's Top Scorer** – Junior left wing **Mark Bomersback (Rochester, Alberta)** is the Bulldogs' top returning scorer in January outings last season. Bomersback tallied six points (3-3-6) in nine games as Ferris State went 2-6-1 (.278). He has at least a point in 10 of his last 13 contests while producing 17 points (8-9-17) in the 13-game span.

➤ **Road Warrior** – **Greg Rallo** has recorded a squad-leading and career season-best 13 points (6-7-13) in 10 road games this season. In 63 career road outings, Rallo has amassed 44 points (19-25-44) which accounts for 46.8% (44-94) of his career points production.

➤ **Fit To Be Tied** – All of Ferris State's five overtime contests this season have resulted in a tie. The last time FSU started out a campaign with ties in its initial five extra-session outings was in the 1998-99 season as the Bulldogs went on to record a 0-1-6 mark while finishing the season at 14-16-6 overall.

➤ **Productive On The Blue Line** – Sophomore defenseman **Jim Jorgensen (Sault Ste. Marie)** is making the most of his second season in a FSU uniform with a career-high 11 points (1-10-11) in 19 games, which is the highest points total among the Bulldogs' blueliners. He generated six points (2-4-6) in 34 contests for the 2004-05 campaign.

➤ **Thirty Something** – Freshman goaltender **Mitch O'Keefe's (Almont, Ontario)** 31 saves at Northern Michigan last Saturday (1/14) marked the fifth time this season in which the netminder has posted 30 or more saves in a contest. O'Keefe totaled a season-high 34 saves against Alaska Fairbanks (11/4).

➤ **Coming Around** – Freshman defenseman **Chris Zarb (Waterford)** has compiled four points (0-4-4) in his last six games after notching two (0-2-2) in his prior 10 outings. Zarb, who was tabbed 11th among the nation's top incoming freshmen defenders by *Inside College Hockey* and is a 2004 NHL fifth-round draft pick by the Philadelphia Flyers, had a pair of helpers in the win at Denver (12/31). He accumulated a combined five points (0-5-5) in his initial 13 contests this season.

➤ **Welcome Back** – **Dan Riedel (Rochester Hills)** returned to the ice for the series at Northern Michigan after being sidelined the last six games due to an illness. Riedel, who was selected by *Inside College Hockey* as the nation's seventh-best incoming freshman forward, ranks third in team scoring with 16 points (3-13-16) in 16 outings after going scoreless in the NMU series.

➤ **Power-Play Woes** – Ferris is operating at 11.6% efficiency (8-69) on the power play in its last 10 outings after going 21.6% (21-97) in its initial 12 contests this season. The Bulldogs were unsuccessful in a combined 11 power-play attempts in their series at Northern Michigan.

➤ **Did You Know?** – Seven of Ferris' last nine games have been decided by two goals or less with the Bulldogs sporting a 3-3-1 record. FSU has claimed a 5-5-5 mark in those encounters this season.

HEAD COACH BOB DANIELS

Bob Daniels, the 2002-03 Spencer Penrose Award recipient as the American Hockey Coaches Association



(AHCA) Division I Coach of the Year and the all-time winningest coach in Ferris State hockey history, is currently in his 14th year at FSU. Under his guidance, the Bulldogs posted a school-record 31-10-1 overall record in 2002-03 while claiming their first-ever Central Collegiate Hockey Association (CCHA) Regular-Season Championship title with a first-

place 22-5-1 league mark.

For his efforts, Daniels was honored as the 2002-03 Coach of the Year by the CCHA, *Inside College Hockey* (INCH) and the March of Dimes West Michigan Sports Awards. Prior to the 2005-06 campaign, Daniels ranked 19th among active NCAA-I hockey coaches in overall victories.

Daniels became Ferris State's all-time winningest coach on March 4, 2000, when the Bulldogs posted a 7-0 regular-season finale victory at Western Michigan. In 1998-99, Daniels notched his 100th career coaching win as the Bulldogs skated to a 2-1 regular-season finale victory at Michigan State, which snapped both the Spartans' 23-game unbeaten streak and 27-game home unbeaten string. He posted his 200th victory with a 6-2 home triumph over Western Michigan on Dec. 4, 2004.

Daniels was appointed FSU's head coach on the eve of the 1992-93 season and in his first campaign, the Bulldogs registered 21 victories and earn a CCHA Tourney Semifinal berth. It signified only the fourth time a Ferris team had won 20 games in a season and the second time in which a rookie coach won more than 16 games at FSU.

An AHCA member, Daniels served a four-year term on the AHCA's Board of Governors and currently is a representative of the NCAA Tournament West Regional Selection Advisory Committee.

- ◆ Ferris State and Bowling Green State meet for the 98th this Monday in a series which originated in the 1978-79 season. The Falcons have a 48-38-11 series lead.
- ◆ **OVERTIME** -- Ferris State has a 6-5-10 record against Bowling Green State in such encounters. The Bulldogs are 3-4-6 on the road and 3-1-6 in home contests.
- ◆ **SHUTOUTS** -- The Bulldogs sport a 2-4-0 mark in those outings -- 0-3-0 on the road and 2-1-0 at home.
- ◆ **THE SITE** -- Ferris is 17-30-5 on the road and 21-18-6 at home versus Bowling Green State.
- ◆ **BOB DANIELS vs. Bowling Green State** -- 19-15-5 overall (8-10-3 on the road and 11-5-3 at home).

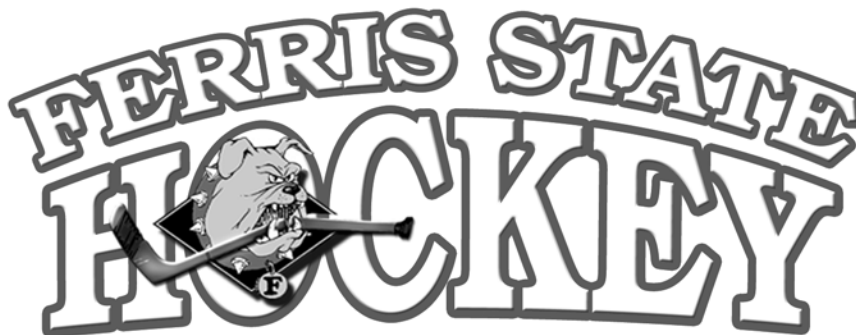
SERIES NOTES -- The Bulldogs are 8-2-1 (.773) in their last 11 meetings versus Bowling Green State -- 3-1-0 on the road and 5-1-1 at home. Ferris is averaging 4.36 goals per game (48 total) during that period while the Falcons are scoring 2.36 goals an outing (26 total) for a +2.0 goals differential.

◆ Ferris State is 11-3-3 (.735) against BGSU in the last 17 meetings between the two teams. The Bulldogs are 5-2-1 on the road and 6-1-2 at home during the 17-game period.

◆ Ferris State is 12-27-0 (.308) in games decided by three goals or more -- 3-17-0 on the road and 9-10-0 at home.

◆ The Bulldogs are 26-21-11 (.543) in contests decided by two goals or less -- 14-13-5 on the road and 12-8-6 at home.
