### FERRIS FACES MICHIGAN TWICE TO FINISH OUT THE REGULAR SEASON

**THIS WEEK:** The Ferris State University men's ice hockey team will close out the regular-season portion of its 2005-06 schedule this weekend (Feb. 24-25) as the Bulldogs take on the nationally-ranked University of Michigan Wolverines in a Central Collegiate Hockey Association (CCHA) home-and-home series. This Friday's (Feb. 24) contest will be held in Big Rapids, Mich., with Saturday's (Feb. 25) series finale taking place in Ann Arbor, Mich. This Saturday's game will be televised live on FSN Detroit.

**FACEOFF/ARENA:** Friday – 7:05 p.m. (EST)/Robert L. Ewigleben (*pronounced A-VAH-glave-in*) Ice Arena (2,493); Saturday – 7:35 p.m. (EST)/Yost Ice Arena (6,637).

**BROADCAST INFORMATION:** All of Ferris State's 2005-06 CCHA games will be carried live by local radio station **Big Country WWBR-100.9 FM** with **Bill Beckwith** calling the action. The contests can be accessed live via the internet by clicking on the Bulldog Athletics Webcasts icon at [www.ferris.edu/sports](http://www.ferris.edu/sports).

**TICKET INFORMATION:** Tickets for all 2005-06 Ferris State Hockey home games are available by contacting the Ewigleben Arena Ticket Office at (231) 591-2888. Hours are Monday thru Friday – 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. (ET) and Saturday (home games only) – 12 to 5 p.m. (ET).

**THE RECORDS:** Ferris State is 14-13-7 overall and 9-11-6 in the CCHA after posting a 0-1-1 mark in a league series versus Ohio State last weekend (Feb. 17-18) at OSU's Value City Arena in Columbus, Ohio. Ferris State is 6-7-3 in its last 16 outings to date and the Bulldogs are listed among other teams receiving votes in this week's (Feb. 20) *U.S. College Hockey Online/CSTV* poll. Last season, Ferris State was 13-22-4 overall with a 10th place-tying 7-17-4 CCHA mark.

**Michigan** is 18-12-4 overall and 13-9-4 in the CCHA to date after going 0-1-1 in a two-game league series against nationally-ranked Nebraska-Omaha last weekend (Feb. 17-18) at the Omaha Civic Auditorium in Omaha, Neb. The Wolverines dropped a 4-3 decision in last Friday's (Feb. 17) series opener before registering a 4-4 overtime tie in Saturday's (Feb. 18) rematch. UM, which is 4-3-1 in its last eight games, is ranked 11th this week in the *U.S. College Hockey Online/CSTV* poll, 12th in the *USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine* poll, and 15th in the *Inside College Hockey* poll.

A season ago, Michigan was 31-8-3 overall with a first-place 23-3-2 CCHA mark. The Wolverines captured both the CCHA regular season and

CCHA Tournament titles in 2004-05. UM also made its NCAA-record 15 straight NCAA Tournament appearance last season and has won two national titles (1996 & 1998) during the streak.

**THE COACHES:** Ferris State – **Bob Daniels** (Michigan State, 1982), 14th season, 222-262-47 (.462) – (9-26-1 vs. Michigan – 6-9-0 Home, 3-15-0 Away, 0-2-1 Neutral). Michigan – **Gordon "Red" Berenson** (Michigan, 1962), 22nd season, 582-275-62 (.667) – (48-20-1 vs. Ferris State). Berenson is UM's all-time winningest coach.

**ABOUT MICHIGAN:** Junior forward T.J. Hensick (14-32-46), a 2004-05 All-CCHA First-Team honoree, and senior forward Andrew Ebbett (11-23-34) are among 12 Wolverines with double-figure points totals this season. Hensick is tied for 11th nationally in points (1.35 ppg.) for UM, which ranks third nationally in scoring offense (3.74 ppg.). Sophomore forwards Kevin Porter (16-17-33) and Chad Kolarik (11-20-31) along with freshman defenseman Jack Johnson (8-21-29) are other top scorers. Johnson is listed eighth nationally among rookies in scoring (0.94 ppg.) and sixth among defensemen. Freshman Billy Sauer (11-5-3, 3.01 GAA, .898sv%) has been the Wolverines' primary goaltender this campaign.

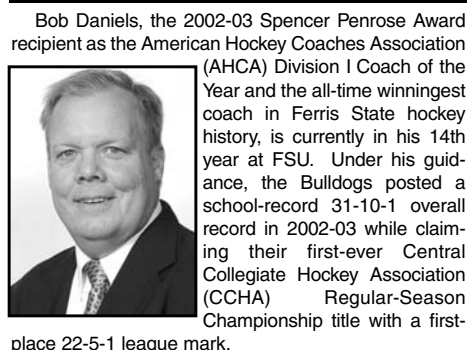

### GAMES THIS WEEK

- **Better Than Before** – Ferris State's 14 victories to date this season (14-13-7 overall) surpasses the team's win total from all of last season (13-22-4 overall).
- **Fit To Be Tied** – The Bulldogs' seven ties this campaign matches a school single-season mark originally set by the 1991-92 squad which finished 13-18-7 overall with a sixth-place 11-15-6 CCHA record under head coach Bob Mancini.
- **Close Encounters** – 15 of Ferris State's last 19 contests have been decided by two goals or less as the Bulldogs are 6-6-3 (.500) in those contests. Seven of the last 13 have been determined by a single goal, which includes the last three games to date (0-2-1 record).
- **Regular Season Finales** – Ferris State is 21-28-3 (.433) all-time in its final two regular-season outings and is 6-8-0 in such encounters since 1998-99. FSU split its last two regular-season games last season (3/4-5) in a home-and-home series versus Western Michigan, losing 6-3 at home and winning 5-2 on the road. The last time Ferris faced Michigan to close out the regular season was in the 1993-94 season (3/5) when the Bulldogs skated to a 6-2 win in Ann Arbor.
- **Rallo Inching Up FSU Record Book** – Senior center **Greg Rallo (Gurnee, Ill.)** currently ranks 32nd in Ferris State's record book with 103 career points (45-58-103) in 146 contests and is one point shy of tying John Gruden (40-64-104; 1990-93) for 31st place. Rallo's 45 career lamplighters is 26th highest on the Bulldogs' all-time goal-scoring list and is one marker away from tying Jeff Jesteadt (26 goals; 1988-92) for 25th place.
- **Senior Night** – The Bulldogs will honor their four seniors prior to this Friday's (2/24) regular-season home finale against Michigan. **Greg Rallo**, goaltender **Tom Mueller (Cadillac)**, right wing **Nick Scheible (Big Rapids)**, and defenseman **Andrew Winnik (Mississauga, Ontario)** will all be recognized. All with the exception of Mueller were members of Ferris' 2002-03 CCHA Championship team which posted a school-record 31-10-1 overall mark.
- **Silver Anniversary** – Ferris' national anthem singer **Rachel Schumann** will be presented with a plaque prior to this Friday's (2/24) game recognizing her 25 years of service singing the anthem at Bulldog home hockey games. Dr. Schumann, a professor at FSU, has produced two musical CDs and also is the president of the Mecosta County Council for the Arts.
- **Miller Time** – Sophomore left wing **Adam Miller's (Livonia)** current four-game point streak (0-4-4) represents a career high, bettering his three-game point string (4-2-6) earlier this season (11/5-11).
- **Consistent Performer** – Junior left wing **Mark Bomersback (Rochester, Alberta)** has notched at least a point in six of his last 10 contests while accumulating eight points (5-3-8) during that span. Bomersback's 27 points (14-13-27) in 34 outings this season is a career best, surpassing his 23 points (7-16-23) in 39 games for the 2004-05 campaign.
- **Back To Full Strength** – Junior defenseman **Jeremy Scherlinck (Grosse Pointe)** has four points (1-3-4) during a current three-game point string. He recorded three points (2-1-3) in his first 21 contests this season and went 14 games (12/10-2/10) without a point until an assist at Notre Dame (2/11). Scherlinck, a 2002-03 CCHA All-Rookie Honorable Mention selection, missed the entire 2004-05 season due to a back injury and also was sidelined 10 games this season with a shoulder injury suffered in the season opener against New Hampshire (10/14) at the Mutual of Omaha Maverick Stampede Tourney in Omaha, Neb.

## HEAD COACH BOB DANIELS



Bob Daniels, the 2002-03 Spencer Penrose Award recipient as the American Hockey Coaches Association (AHCA) Division I Coach of the Year and the all-time winningest coach in Ferris State hockey history, is currently in his 14th year at FSU. Under his guidance, the Bulldogs posted a school-record 31-10-1 overall record in 2002-03 while claiming their first-ever Central Collegiate Hockey Association (CCHA) Regular-Season Championship title with a first-

place 22-5-1 league mark.

For his efforts, Daniels was honored as the 2002-03 Coach of the Year by the CCHA, *Inside College Hockey* (INCH) and the March of Dimes West Michigan Sports Awards. Prior to the 2005-06 campaign, Daniels ranked 19th among active NCAA-I hockey coaches in overall victories.

Daniels became Ferris State's all-time winningest coach on March 4, 2000, when the Bulldogs posted a 7-0 regular-season finale victory at Western Michigan. In 1998-99, Daniels notched his 100th career coaching win as the Bulldogs skated to a 2-1 regular-season finale victory at Michigan State, which snapped both the Spartans' 23-game unbeaten streak and 27-game home unbeaten string. He posted his 200th victory with a 6-2 home triumph over Western Michigan on Dec. 4, 2004.

Daniels was appointed FSU's head coach on the eve of the 1992-93 season and in his first campaign, the Bulldogs registered 21 victories and earn a CCHA Tourney Semifinal berth. It signified only the fourth time a Ferris team had won 20 games in a season and the second time in which a rookie coach won more than 16 games at FSU.

An AHCA member, Daniels served a four-year term on the AHCA's Board of Governors and currently is a representative of the NCAA Tournament West Regional Selection Advisory Committee.
