The Ferris Hockey Skill Center is open to youth ages 7 to 18 (please choose appropriate age session when registering) at all levels of skill development. However, applicants must have previous hockey playing experience. Note: Campers must be at least 9 years old to stay in our residence halls.

Fees

RESIDENT PLAN: \$495/week

Our Resident Plan includes 12 on-ice sessions, classroom instruction, off-ice training, room and board, your practice jersey and recreation. Players will be housed Sunday night through Thursday afternoon in one of our modern college residence halls. Meals will be served beginning with Sunday dinner and ending with Thursday's lunch.

COMMUTER PLAN: \$375/week

Our Commuter Plan includes 12 on-ice sessions, classroom instruction, off-ice training, practice jersey, recreation, lunch and dinner Monday through Wednesday and lunch on Thursday.

7- to 9-YEAR OLD COMMUTER ONLY: \$195/week

Week No. 1 Commuter Only Camp includes two on-ice session and one session of dry-land training and lunch daily.
