## FERRIS STATE WOMEN'S SOCCER NEW RECRUITING CLASS

Big Rapids, Mich. – The Ferris State University women's soccer program has received commitments from nine student-athletes to attend and play women's soccer at FSU, beginning this fall. The announcement was made by third-year head coach Pete Watkins .

The nine-member recruiting class is comprised of Kelly Flynn (Portage) , Jennifer Gaylor (Roscommon) , Lauren Hogan (Ann Arbor/Huron) , Frances Kilbride (Shelby Township/Lutheran Northern) , Kelly Kline (Battle Creek/Harper Creek) , Danielle McAllister (Lowell/Grand Rapids Baptist) , Shawna Orcutt (Bloomingdale, Ill./Glenbard), Kathleen Rickertsen (St. Charles, Ill.) and Chelsea Rustin (Dearborn, Mich./Crestwood) . The squad will also add two walk-ons in the fall.

"We're very excited and fortunate to be bringing in these fine student-athletes to campus," said Watkins. "They are the type of individuals who will make us a better team and will create a competitive atmosphere at every position, which we need to become a force in the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC)."
