

## ASSISTANT COACHES/ALL-TIME COACHING RECORDS

### KRIS ST. ANDRE

After concluding a productive career at Ferris State University, Kris St. Andre is embarking on her second season as an assistant coach.

A native of Jackson, Mich., St. Andre played two seasons (1999-00) at Ferris State and helped the Bulldogs to a combined 79-36 overall record during her career. She compiled a .288 (77-267) career batting average while hitting five home runs and registering 47 RBIs in 99 contests. In her senior campaign, she batted .289 (44-152) after posting a .287 batting average (33-115) in the 1999 season.



Prior to Ferris State, St. Andre played two seasons (1997-98) at Grand Rapids (Mich.) Community College. While at GRCC, St. Andre helped guide the Raiders to a pair of conference and regional championship titles apiece under coach Paula Maloley. She batted .362 (47-130) in her final season at GRCC and was selected the school's 1998 Female Athlete-of-the-Year.

A 1996 graduate of Jackson (Mich.) Lumen Christi High School, St. Andre was a four-time Capital Area Conference and three-time all-region selection in softball under coach Mike Tash. An all-state pick as a senior, she was named the Titans' MVP and team captain three times. St. Andre holds school marks for batting average (.533), doubles and triples.

St. Andre received a bachelor's degree in education from Ferris State in the spring of 2001. She has aspirations of becoming a softball head coach at the collegiate level. St. Andre, who resides in Big Rapids, is the daughter of John and Donna St. Andre.

### LESA BICKLEY

Joining the Ferris State softball program this season is volunteer assistant coach Lesa Bickley, who will work primarily with the Bulldogs' pitching corps.

Bickley is certainly no stranger to the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference after having served as head coach at the University of Findlay (Ohio) for three years (1998-00). While at UF, Bickley compiled a 64-64-1 coaching mark and guided the Oilers to a 21-16-0 overall record in her final season. In 1999, she coached Findlay to the NAIA independent Great Lakes Region sectional tournament title as the Oilers went on to make a regional tourney appearance.



Prior to Findlay, Bickley was head softball coach at New Riegel (Ohio) High School (1995-97) where her teams won three sectional championships along with a district and regional title in 1996.

A four-year letterwinner in softball at Ashland (Ohio) University, Bickley earned All-Great Lakes Valley Conference (GLVC) honors and was the conference's Pitcher-of-the-Year as a junior. She also was a two-time all-region selection and was recognized as an Academic All-American. Bickley, who graduated from Ashland in 1991 with a bachelor's degree in education, is currently working towards completing her Masters of Education degree.
