COLLEGE: 2003: Talented player with a promising future . . . Will be expected to pitch more this season . . . Overall hitting skills have improved . . . Handles pressure situations well . . . Great arm and quick release . . . **2002:** Started 42 games . . . Placed third among squad's leaders in pitching appearances (10), innings pitched (43.2), strikeouts (24) and earned run average (3.37) . . . Pitched a season-high 10 innings vs. Northwood (4/9) giving up eight hits and three runs in her only victory . . . Allowed only six hits and one run vs. Findlay (4/27) . . . Totaled six strikeouts and surrendered two runs vs. Mercyhurst (4/14) . . . Compiled a .250 batting average with eight hits and five runs scored . . .
