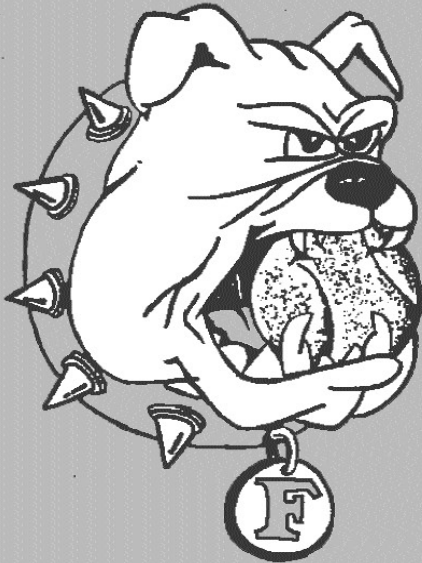

2003-04 SEASON NOTES

- ❖ Ferris State has won 183 of its last 187 Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) regular-season matches. The Bulldogs won 162 consecutive league outings from Sept. 4, 1984, to Oct. 12, 2001, when Northwood ended FSU's streak with a 6-3 triumph in Midland, Mich. FSU, which has advanced to the NCAA-II Regional Tournament nine consecutive years (1996-04), has claimed the regional title and earned a bid to the NCAA-II Championships four of the past six seasons to date. The Bulldogs reached the NCAA-II national quarterfinals in its 14th all-time tournament appearance this season after winning a Great Lakes Regional title.
- ❖ Ferris State placed second overall in the 2003 GLIAC Tournament (10/24-25) at the Midland Community Tennis Center in Midland, Mich., after dropping a 5-2 decision to Northwood in the title match. FSU claimed a share of the 2002 league title by defeating Northern Michigan (10/26/02) and finished third overall in 2001 when NMU ended FSU's 17-year GLIAC title reign. Ferris has won 18 of the last 20 league titles to date.
- ❖ Senior **Barbora Jilkova**, who received 2001-02 Intercollegiate Tennis Association Division II Doubles All-America recognition, and sophomore **Laura Schaefer** claimed the 2003 Intercollegiate Tennis Association Great Lakes Doubles Championship (Sept. 19-21) at the Indianapolis Tennis Center in Indianapolis, Ind. They then advanced and placed seventh at the 2003 ITA National Small College Championships, which were held Oct. 16-19 in Corpus Christi, Texas. Jilkova and former standout Jennifer Garvey (1998-02) are FSU's only All-America performers.
- ❖ The Bulldogs have won 92 consecutive league regular-season home contests at FSU's Racquet and Fitness Center to date. Ferris has currently won 122 of its last 131 regular-season home encounters.
