Coach Brandel-Wilhelm on Doyle: "Meredith is coming off a summer injury, but will give us great depth at both the outside and right-side hitter positions."

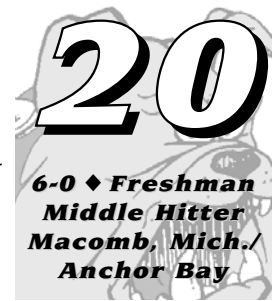

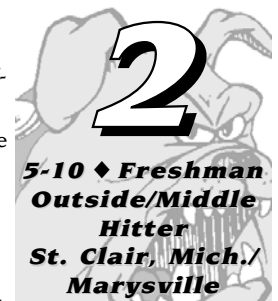
