Coach Brandel-Wilhelm on Rich: "Andrea had an amazing offseason and has improved her skills, control and consistency. She has the ability as a setter to adjust to her teammates and has stepped up in terms of leadership as well."

College: 2005: Saw action in 11 matches while appearing in 22 total games . . . Placed third on the team with 92 assists . . . Also recorded 30 digs, six service aces and two kills . . . Had 18 assists in the season-opening win over West Virginia State (8/25) . . . Compiled a season-high 23 assists along with nine digs versus Lees-McRae (N.C.) in the Ferris State Holiday Inn Invitational (8/26) . . . Totaled 10 assists or more in five different encounters . . . College: 2005: Started 20 matches and played in 110 games . . . Finished third on squad in kills (283), fourth in digs (211) along with fifth in both total blocks (40) and aces (26) . . . Had more than 10 kills in 13 matches . . . Compiled 10 or more digs seven times . . . Had 25 digs and 14 kills at Wayne State (10/15) . . . Notched 15 kills and 24 digs versus Lake Superior State (10/2) . . . Tallied 18 kills along with 10 digs at LSSU (10/28) . . . Posted seven kills and six digs in NCAA-II Tournament action against Southern Illinois-Edwardsville (11/17) . . . 2004: Appeared in 17 matches . . . Played in 31 games . . . Tied for seventh among team leaders with 15 service aces . . . Totaled a season-high five kills versus Fairmont State, W.Va. (9/11) . . . Chipped in six service aces against West Virginia State (8/27) in the Ferris State Invitational . . . Notched two kills in her collegiate debut against Midwestern State, Texas (8/27) . . . Had at least one kill in her first six appearances . . . Registered 17 digs at Mercyhurst (10/9) . . . Tallied three block assists versus St. Joseph's, Ind. (8/28) . . . Placed ninth on squad with 17 kills . . . Also totaled 33 digs and six block assists on the year . . . Recorded at least two kills in five outings.
