2008 FSU Volleyball will be fun to watch because: "Our intensity and high energy level."

**College: 2007:** Started in all 30 matches . . . Tops on the team with 90 blocks . . . Netted a squad-leading 21 block solos . . . Recorded a block in 25-of-30 matches on the season . . . Led the Bulldogs in blocks during GLIAC matches with a 0.87 average . . . Finished fifth among the team's leaders in kills (146) while her .217 attack percentage represented the fourth-best season output . . . Totaled a season-leading 10 kills on two occasions – vs. Adams State, Colo. (8/31) at the Days Inn-Denver West Oredigger Classic and against Gannon (10/5) . . . Produced nine kills at Michigan Tech (10/19) and against Northwood (11/3) . . . Registered a .692 hitting percentage against Adams State (8/31) with 10 kills in 13 attack attempts . . . Generated a .643 hitting percentage on 10 kills in 14 tries with only one error vs. Gannon (10/5) . . . Garnered a season single-match eight total blocks (seven block assists) against Lake Superior State (9/14) while making seven total blocks apiece in a non-league match vs. Mesa State, Colo. (9/1) at the Days Inn-Denver West Oredigger Classic and against Northern Michigan (9/16) . . . Averaged 1.61 kills per game with a .242 hitting percentage in 18 conference matches . . . **High School:** A 2007 graduate of Grand Rapids (Mich.) Central High . . . Paced 2006-07 team in all statistical categories as a senior en route to be tabbed as squad's MVP for the second consecutive season . . . Prepped by Elyssa Trevino . . . A three-time (2004-05, 2005-06, and 2006-07) first-team All-City League honoree . . . Earned all-area accolades in both junior and senior seasons . . . Served as the Rams' team captain in her final two prep seasons . . . Didn't start playing the sport until her freshman season . . . Also competed four years in basketball . . . Selected as school's Homecoming Queen in 2006 and also won the school's mock rock competition . . . Voted as school's top athlete in her senior year . . .
