College: 2001: Played in 100 games . . . Recorded five double digit kill performances . . . Tallied a season-high 13 kills at Ashland (9/28) . . . Notched 10 kills and 15 digs versus Northern Michigan (9/16) . . . Registered 12 kills against Mercyhurst in the opening round of the GLIAC Tournament (11/8) . . . Had 10 kills or more in three of Ferris' final six outings . . . Accumulated 13 digs or more in three matches . . . Posted 14 digs and nine kills versus Mercyhurst (10/6) . . . Recorded six kills in nine total attempts for a .667 attack percentage against Saginaw Valley State (11/1) . . . Tallied 13 kills at Ashland (9/28).

High School: A 2001 graduate of Rogers City High School . . . Was a two-time first-team all-state pick . . . Earned Most Valuable Player honors three times at Rogers City . . . Earned first-team all-state accolades in softball . . . Was a prep all-state honorable mention basketball selection . . . Received all-conference honors in softball, basketball and volleyball . . . Led Rogers City to its second-straight district title, the Straits Area Conference championship and a state semifinal appearance during the 1999-2000 campaign . . .
