College: **2001:** Earned All-GLIAC, All-Great Lakes Region, GLIAC Tournament and GLIAC All-Academic Team recognition . . . Recorded the school's best single-match attack percentage (.778) versus Wisconsin-Parkside (8/25) . . . Led FSU with 405 kills . . . Had 10 kills or more in 25 matches . . . Registered a career-high 23 kills against Lewis (9/8) . . . Earned second-team Daktronics All-Great Lakes Region accolades and was FSU's Bulldog Award winner . . . **2000:** Saw action in 29 matches . . . Made 14 starts . . . Ranked fourth on the team in total kills (215) . . . Had 18 kills at Saginaw Valley State (9/30) . . . Totaled 20 blocks versus Northern Kentucky (9/9) . . .
