### 5-9 ♦ Sophomore ♦ Setter Tiffin, Ohio (Bascom Hopewell-Loudon)

**Coach Brandel-Wilhelm on Clouse:** "Emily is a confident and competitive player who gained valuable experience as a freshman. She is recovering from a shoulder surgery in the spring, but should compete strongly for us at the setter position."

**College: 2002:** Saw action in 14 matches . . . Appeared in 19 games . . . Totaled 90 assists, which ranked second among the squad's leaders . . . Added 15 digs and seven kills . . . Posted a personal career-high 34 assists, eight digs and two kills in her first career start versus Ashland (10/4) . . . Registered 13 assists against Lake Superior State (10/26) . . . Tallied 10 assists versus Alderson-Broadus (9/1) at the Wheeling Jesuit (W.Va.) Invitational . . . Recorded a .235 season hitting percentage.

**High School:** A 2002 graduate of Bascom Hopewell-Loudon High School . . . Led the Chieftains to their fourth consecutive Ohio High School Athletic Association (OHSAA) Division IV State Championship as a senior . . . Was a two-time (2000-01) All-OHSAA Division IV All-State pick . . . Honored as a two-time first-team all-district selection . . . Registered 802 assists, 109 digs and 41 kills in her final season . . . Twice received first-team All-Midland Athletic League laurels . . . Named team's top server in 1999-00 . . . Totaled 732 assists, 98 digs and 36 kills as a junior . . . Was a three-time (1998-01) academic all-state selection . . . Earned four varsity letters under head coach Dave Rienhart . . . **Club Team:** Played for the Black Swamp Volleyball Club.

### 5-11 ♦ Junior ♦ Outside Hitter Rogers City, Mich.

**Coach Brandel-Wilhelm on Fairbanks:** "Karla has developed her overall game in the past year. She's a powerful player and a hard-working athlete. Her control and finesse have improved, which should make her a more complete player."

**College: 2002:** Started 30 matches and played 115 games . . . Placed second among team leaders in kills (429), blocks (54) and service aces (48) . . . Totaled 24 double-figure kill outings, including a personal career-high 25 versus Southern Indiana (9/13) . . . GLIAC All-Academic Team pick . . . Registered 19 kills and 13 digs against Southern Illinois-Edwardsville (9/13) . . . Recorded 22 kills and 12 digs versus Henderson State (9/6) . . . Notched a team-high 20 kills and nine digs against Wheeling Jesuit (11/22) in the NCAA-II Tournament . . . **2001:** Played in 100 games . . . Recorded five double digit kill performances . . . Tallied a season-high 13 kills at Ashland (9/28) . . . Placed fifth among the team's leaders in both total kills (166) and kills per game (1.66 kpg) . . . Notched 10 kills and 15 digs versus Northern Michigan (9/16) . . . Had 10 kills or more in three of Ferris' final six outings . . . Accumulated 13 digs or more in three matches . . . Posted 14 digs and nine kills versus Mercyhurst (10/6) . . . Recorded six kills in nine attempts for a .667 attack percentage against Saginaw Valley State (11/1).

**High School:** A 2001 graduate of Rogers City High School . . . Was a two-time first-team all-state pick . . . Earned Most Valuable Player honors three times . . . Attained first-team all-state softball accolades . . . Was a prep all-state honorable mention basketball selection . . . Received all-conference honors in softball, basketball and volleyball . . . Led RCHS to a district title, the Straits Area Conference championship and a state semifinal appearance in 1999-00 . . . Coached by Kristy Smolinski . . . **Club Team:** Played for the Team Angle club volleyball team.
