**Coach Brandel-Wilhelm on Heine:** "Lauren is a competitive player who will play a bigger role this season. She has the ability to compete both at the middle and right-side hitter positions. Her experiences as a freshman helped her improve."

**College: 2002:** Completed in 14 matches . . . Tallied 22 kills, seven digs and four block assists in 19 games . . .

Attained a season-high 10 kills and two digs versus Southeastern Oklahoma (9/6) at the Harding (Ark.) Invitational . . . Earned the squad's Coaches Award . . . Registered four kills and two digs against Lake Superior State (10/26) . . . Totaled three kills at Saginaw Valley State (11/8) . . . Ranked seventh among team leaders in kills per game (1.16 kpg) . . . Made her initial collegiate appearance versus Bellarmine (8/31) at the Wheeling Jesuit (W.Va.) Invitational.

**High School:** A 2002 graduate of Ypsilanti High School . . . Totaled 351 kills, 289 digs and 151 total blocks while leading Ypsilanti to a 32-12-3 overall record in her final season . . . Was a two-time (2001-02) All-Michigan Mega Red Conference selection . . . Earned honorable mention all-state accolades . . . Twice received second-team *Detroit News* All-Metro honors . . . Named the team's Most Valuable Player Award winner four consecutive years . . . Served as team captain twice and was a two-time all-region honoree . . . Prepped by Phil Lozen . . . Compiled 320 kills, 271 digs and 157 total blocks as a junior . . . **Club Team:** Competed for the Motor City, USA Michigan and Go Blue Club Volleyball programs.

**Coach Brandel-Wilhelm on Miller:** "Sarah is a strong blocker who has made significant gains on the offensive side. We're expecting her to increase her role and compete for a starting spot at any of the front row positions this year."

**College: 2002:** Saw action in 11 matches . . . Notched 17 kills, seven digs and four block assists in 18 games . . .

Totaled a season-high four kills versus Saginaw Valley State (9/28) . . . Posted three kills and two block assists against Lake Superior State (10/26) . . . Had three digs and two block assists in a win over Ashland (10/4) . . . Recorded first career kill in her debut versus Bellarmine (8/31) . . . Garnered the squad's second-best season attack percentage (.295) . . . Tallied two kills in her final appearance at Saginaw Valley State (11/8) . . . Registered two kills and a service ace versus St. Joseph's (9/1) . . . Produced two assists at Lake Superior State (10/1) . . . **2001:** Redshirted . . .
