Coach Brandel-Wilhelm on Baucher: "Danielle gained valuable experience as a freshman. She's worked hard to become an excellent passer and defensive player. In addition to being versatile, Danielle's also extremely confident."

College: 2003: Started all 29 matches . . . Ranked third among team leaders with 250 kills and 314 digs . . . Compiled six double-double (kills & digs) efforts . . . Totaled a season-high 24 digs versus Northern Michigan (9/26) . . . Recorded 10 or more digs in 17 outings . . . Notched 17 kills and 19 digs against Gannon in the GLIAC Tournament (11/13) . . . Reached double-figures in digs 13 times in the final 16 matches . . . Had 20 digs and nine kills at Wayne State (10/17) . . . Tallied 16 kills versus Southern Indiana (9/12) . . . Posted squad's third-best service ace total (42) . . . Averaged 2.78 digs per game . . . Netted a team-high nine kills in collegiate debut at North Florida (8/29).

College: 2003: Participated in 107 games . . . Earned team Coaches Award recognition . . . Placed fifth on squad with 191 digs . . . Attained 76 assists and 19 service aces . . . Garnered 10 or more digs in eight matches . . . Recorded a personal career-high 16 digs versus Northern Michigan (9/26) . . . Started 26 contests as a defensive specialist . . . Totaled 15 digs at Grand Valley State (10/7) . . . Twice registered 14 digs in a match . . . GLIAC All-Academic Team member . . . **2002:** Saw action in 14 matches . . . Appeared in 19 games . . . Totaled 90 assists, which ranked second among the squad's leaders . . . Added 15 digs and seven kills . . .
