Coach Brandel-Wilhelm on Fairbanks: "Karla has developed her overall game and confidence in her years at Ferris. She's a powerful player, hard-working athlete and a dedicated leader. She'll be one of the top outside hitters in the country this season."

College: 2003: Attained AVCA Division II Honorable Mention All-America accolades . . . Was a first-team All-GLIAC, AVCA All-Great Lakes Region and Daktronics All-Region honoree . . . Twice named GLIAC Player of the Week . . . Received GVSU Days Inn Classic All-Tourney Team honors . . . Led squad in kills (516), digs (336) and service aces (58) . . . Recorded school's second-highest single-match kills total with 35 against North Alabama (9/5) . . . Totaled 26 double-figure kill efforts . . . Had 16 double-doubles (kills & digs) . . . Named team's co-MVP . . . Ranked third among league's kills leaders . . . Netted 33 kills and 23 digs versus Gannon at the GLIAC Tourney (11/13) . . . Registered 28 kills and 25 digs versus Gannon (10/10) . . . **2002:** Started 30 matches and played 115 games . . . Placed second among team leaders in kills (429), blocks (54) and service aces (48) . . . Totaled 24 double-figure kill outings, including a personal career-high 25 versus Southern Indiana (9/13) . . . GLIAC All-Academic Team pick . . . **2001:** Played in 100 games . . . Recorded five double digit kill performances . . . Tallied a season-high 13 kills at Ashland (9/28) . . . Placed fifth among the team's leaders in both total kills (166) and kills per game (1.66 kpg).
