College: 2004: Became first libero in GLIAC history to attain second team all-conference recognition . . . Second-Team Daktronics All-Great Lakes Region . . . GLIAC All-Academic Team member . . . FSU Bulldog Award winner . . . Ranked second on team with 396 digs . . . Added 21 service aces . . . Registered 10 digs or more in 20 matches . . . Had four 20-plus dig outings . . . Recorded 25 digs at Grand Valley State (10/21) . . . Served three aces versus Findlay (9/17) . . . Netted 22 digs versus Southern Indiana (11/19) in NCAA Tournament . . . **2003:** Played in all 113 games . . . Earned team Bulldog Award honors . . . College: 2004: Tied school's fifth-best seasonal block assists mark (138) . . . Chosen to GLIAC All-Tourney Team . . . Had team-high 150 blocks . . . Posted five double-figure kill outings . . . Tallied 14 block assists versus Ashland (11/13) in league tourney . . . Compiled 12 block assists against Northern Michigan (11/10) in conference tourney quarterfinals . . . Twice had 12 kills in a single match . . . Started 24 matches and appeared in 107 games . . . **2003:** Saw action in 29 outings . . . Ranked fourth on team in kills (221) . . . Notched eight double-digit kill performances . . . Was squad's total blocks leader (120) . . . Appeared in 112 of 113 games . . . Had 14 kills and five blocks versus Gannon (10/10) . . . Totaled 14 kills and seven blocks against Northern Michigan (9/26) . . . **2002:** Competed in 14 matches . . . Tallied 22 kills, seven digs and four block assists in 19 games . . . Attained a season-high 10 kills and two digs versus Southeastern Oklahoma (9/6) . . . Earned the squad's Coaches Award . . . Registered four kills and two digs against Lake Superior State (10/26) . . . Ranked seventh among team leaders in kills per game (1.16 kpg) . . . Made collegiate debut versus Bellarmine (8/31).
