Dictionaries

Dictionary of Optometry and Visual Science: This source defines important terms in visual science, including both optometry and ophthalmology.

Dictionary of Ophthalmic Optics: This source defines important terms in optics relating to the eye and vision.

General Sources

Duane's Clinical Ophthalmology [7 vols.]: This reference is updated annually and covers a broad range of eye diseases and topics. It is one of the first places to go to find vision science information. The last volume is an Index and a good place to begin searching. Newer chapters have color pictures. Also comes in CD format available from the Check-Out Desk.

Ophthalmology: A comprehensive general reference on ophthalmology. The major topics are color-coded with an index at the end in gray. Mainly color pictures are provided.

Ophthalmic Pathology: An Atlas and Textbook [4 vols.]: A comprehensive general reference on eye disease. Many black and white disease photos are included.

Principles and Practice of Ophthalmology [6 vols.]: Another good general reference on eye disease and physiology. Each book in this series has the diseases it covers on the spine and there is a general index at the end of each volume. Mainly color pictures are provided
