2007-08 Ashland Basketball Preseason Preview

The Eagles must replace four starters from a team that went 16-12, 8-9 in GLIAC play and advanced to the first round of the GLIAC playoffs. While last year's team was built around powerful senior forward Greg Emmons, this year's team will revolve around the backcourt. Last year's team featured two players – Emmons and guard-forward Vahn Knight – who scored over 1,000 points in their careers. This year's team doesn't have that kind of established, veteran presence.

One returnee who can be counted on is senior guard **Brett Bartlett (LaGrange, OH/Kent State)**. The 6-0 Bartlett averaged 15.5 ppg., a year ago, second on the team and established a school, single-season record for three-point field goals (91). Bartlett was second in the GLIAC in three-pointers per game (3.25), sixth in free three percentage (.833) and eighth in scoring and three-point field goal percentage (.435).

Bartlett is moving from point guard to off-guard to make room in the lineup for 5-11 **Bret Wackerly (Canton, OH/Canisius)**, a transfer from Canisius. The hope is that Bartlett and Wackerly can provide the Eagles with one of the quickest, and best shooting backcourts, in the conference.

Another legitimate outside threat is 6-3 senior **Steve Gansey (Olmsted Falls, OH/Cleveland State)**, who averaged 5.9 ppg., last season. Gansey was fifth in the GLIAC in three-point field goal percentage (.444) last season. He thrived coming off the bench. This year, he'll be part of the starting lineup.

Last season's sixth man, 6-6, 190-pound junior forward **Tyler Rosenberger (Elmore, OH/Woodmore)**, is also stepping into the starting lineup for the first time. Rosenberger was the most improved player on last year's team when he averaged 5.2 ppg., and 4.3 rpg., in 24.2 minutes per game. The Eagles figure to be one of the GLIAC's smallest teams and Roseberger will be counted on to provide a consistent rebounding presence. One thing the junior does do is make the offense work – he shot 55.8 percent from the floor a year ago.

The fourth new starter is 6-8, 250-pound redshirt freshman **Kale Richardson (Carroll, OH/Bloom-Carroll)**. He's Ashland's biggest player and must provide rebounding and interior defense if the Eagles are to return to the GLIAC playoffs.

A year ago, Ashland led the conference in scoring (78.4 ppg.), free throw percentage (.772) and three-point field goals per game (10.11). The Eagles were second in the country in treys per game. AU head coach **Roger Lyons** (224-162, 15th year) has stated that his goal is to remain the conference leader in all three departments. If the Eagles do that, it means that their running game is moving at its familiar speed. The biggest challenge facing Lyons and his staff is determining who will support his starting five. The bench spots must be sorted out in the early part of the season. The roster lists six true freshmen and nine newcomers.

NOTES

** The Ferris men's basketball team registered its fourth-straight Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) Tournament appearance in 2006-07 under head coach **Bill Sall** and concluded the year with a 10-18 overall record. The Bulldogs placed tied for third in the GLIAC North Division regular-season standings with a 8-10 league slate after advancing to the NCAA Division II Great Lakes Regional Tournament the previous two seasons. FSU captured back-to-back GLIAC North Division titles in 2003-04 and 2004-05 along with advancing to the NCAA-II Sweet Sixteen two years ago.

** Ferris State capped off a banner 2004-05 season under **Bill Sall** with a runner-up finish in the NCAA Division II Great Lakes Regional Tournament (March 12-15) held in Findlay, Ohio. FSU reached the regional championship game for only the third time in school history two years ago. The Bulldogs concluded the 2004-05 season with a 24-7 overall record and fell one game shy of advancing to the NCAA-II Elite Eight for the second time ever. FSU's 24 victories represented the third-most seasonal wins in school history.

** Sixth-year FSU head coach **Bill Sall**, who served for four seasons (1998-2002) as the assistant men's basketball coach at GLIAC-member Hillsdale (Mich.) College, previously was the top assistant coach at Ferris State for three seasons (1995-98) and spent part of the 1995-96 campaign as the Bulldogs' interim head coach. In his brief tenure, Ferris recorded a 5-8 start under Sall before finishing the year with a 6-20 overall record.

** Ferris State's impressive basketball tradition includes 11 GLIAC titles, eight NCAA Division II Tournament appearances and a berth in the 1988 NCAA-II Elite Eight. Ferris, which last won the GLIAC Tournament championship during the 1997-98 campaign, captured a league record four consecutive conference titles from 1986-90. FSU has won more GLIAC Championships (11) than any other league member.

** The Bulldogs had posted only a 21-82 (.204) mark in the four seasons prior to **Bill Sall's** arrival, but has since went 77-67 (.535) and claimed two divisional titles while making two NCAA-II Tournament appearances in his five seasons at the helm. FSU won only four games (4-22) the year before Sall arrived in 2001-02.

** Ferris returns two starters and four letterwinners from the last campaign. Among the players lost from last season was forward **Terrance Shaw**, who earned All-GLIAC Second Team accolades the last two seasons. One of the four returning letterwinners is two-sport athlete **C.J. Van Wieren**, who is the starting quarterback for the Ferris State football team this fall. He will join the squad at the conclusion of the football campaign.

** This year's Bulldog roster includes nine players who were not in the program last campaign in addition to **Lou Williams**, who redshirted in his initial Bulldog season last year. Nine of the 14 players on the roster are freshmen.

2007-08 Preview

Michigan Tech returns a solid lineup to the floor in 2007-08 with hopes of adding some offensive firepower to its proven strength on defense. The Huskies finished their second consecutive season among the nation's top 15 in field goal percentage defense and scoring defense a year ago by holding foes to 39.7 percent and 61.9 points per game.

Senior Tim Strom is Tech's top returning player. The 6-7 forward averaged 13.5 points and team highs of 5.5 rebounds and 2.1 assists per game in 2006-07. He earned All-Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference North Division Second Team honors.

Three other starters return. Junior point guard Robbie Springborn is a two-year starter for the Huskies, as is senior guard Josh Makela. Center Kris Alpers is primed for a breakout season with a year of experience at Michigan Tech under his belt. He transferred from NCAA Division I Lipscomb prior to the 2006-07 campaign.

Freshman Don Fowler, a 6-2 guard from St. Clair Shores, Mich., is the team's top newcomer and should make an immediate impact for the Huskies.

Head coach Kevin Luke begins his 14th season on the Tech bench. The four-time GLIAC Coach of the Year and 2002-03 National Coach of the Year owns a career record of 247-131.
