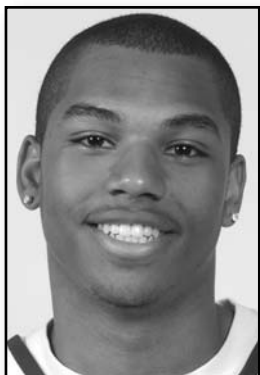

2008-09: Preseason All-GLIAC honoree ... Made huge strides last season ... Became a consistent scorer ... One of league's top offensive threats on the inside ... Developed into an impact player ... Runs floor well ... Has become team's best low post options ... Coming into his own ... Making significant progress at the collegiate level ... Has improved overall conditioning level.

College: 2007-08: Started 27 of 29 games ... Led team in scoring (15.9 ppg.) and rebounding (6.9 rpg.) ... Had 26 double-figure scoring performances ... Earned team MVP Award honors ... Scored 20 points or more eight times ... Ranked ninth in scoring and 10th in rebounding among the GLIAC's overall leaders ... Was also ninth in the league in field goal and free throw percentage ... Finished with six double-double (points & rebounds) efforts ... Named to the AT&T Alascom Jamboree All-Tourney Team (Dec. 29-30) ... Attempted 24 more free throws than any other GLIAC player ... Had 52 more attempts than any player found among the top 15 league leaders in free throw percentage ... Converted 167 of 212 (.788) tries from the charity stripe ... Had season-high 27 points vs. Wayne State (1/9) ... Scored 10 points or more in 12 of his final 13 games ... Recorded 25 points against Kuyper (1/3) and netted 23 points at St. Joseph's (12/17) ... Also had 23 points at Tiffin (12/8) and 22 points against Gannon (1/17) ... Shot 53.9% (145-269) from the floor for the season.

High School: A 2007 graduate of Grand Rapids' Ottawa Hills High School ... *Detroit News* Class A Honorable Mention All-State basketball selection ... All-City selection ... Also earned all-area and all-league accolades ... Coached by Lee Gilbert ... Two-year varsity letterwinner ... Tallied 15 points, 10 rebounds and two assists per game as a senior for the Bengals ... Helped squad to a 16-4 overall record in 2006-07 ... Chosen as team's Most Valuable Player Award recipient ... Two-sport student-athlete ... Received *Associated Press* Class A All-State Honorable Mention football honors as a lineman in 2006 ... All-City football honoree ... Earned four varsity letters in football.

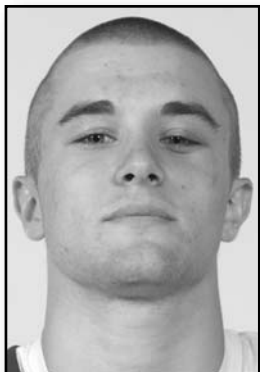

2008-09: Tremendous work ethic ... Made significant progress last season ... Developing ability to be a good team leader ... Solid understanding of the game ... Competing for a starting job ... Continues to make improvements in shooting touch ... Comes from a great prep system.

College: 2007-08: Started 15 of 29 contests ... Reached double-figure scoring nine times, including seven of his final nine outings ... Had season-high 23 points with five three-pointers at Ashland (1/31) ... Dished out three assists or more in 13 contests with six against Kuyper (1/3) ... Recorded 16 points in two different games - vs. Northern Michigan (2/7) and at Hillsdale (2/14) ... Totaled nine points in his collegiate debut at home vs. Hillsdale (11/17) ... Shot 45.5% (70-154) from the field and was 28-of-72 (.389) beyond the three-point line ... Made 33-of-45 (.733) field goal attempts for the season ... Had four steals in two different contests and a season-high five rebounds in four games ... Shot 50% or better from the three-point line in nine outings ... Played 711 total minutes and finished with 201 points, 72 rebounds and 64 assists ... Was team's third-leading scorer, placed second in assists along with third in field goal percentage, steals and three-pointers made.

High School: A 2007 graduate of Rockford High School ... Guided team to both an Ottawa-Kent (OK) Conference Red Division title and district crown as the squad's leading scorer his senior year ... Coached by Steve Majerle ... 2007 Class A All-State Honorable Mention recipient ... Played Amateur Athletic Union (AAU) basketball for the Grand Rapids Storm ... Rated as Michigan's number 11 point guard in the senior class by *InsidePrepSports.com* ... Three-year letterwinner ... Averaged 14 points, 4.5 assists and 3.5 rebounds per game as a prep senior ... Helped team to a regional runner-up finish in 2006-07 ... Two-time all-conference pick ... All-Area selection ... Team captain ... Averaged 10 points, 3.5 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game his junior campaign ... Tallied 5.0 points, 3.0 assists and 2.5 boards per contest as a sophomore ... Also competed in track and field.
