

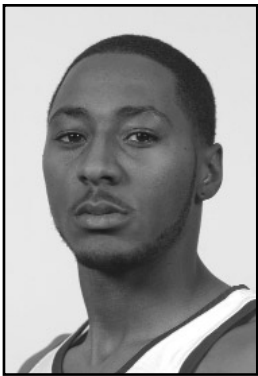

Scored two points and dished out an assist in seven minutes of action at Southern Indiana (12/29) ... Totaled two points and three rebounds in a season-high 13 minutes of action versus Hillsdale (1/11) ... Grabbed five total rebounds and had four assists ... Was 2-of-9 (.222) from the floor and averaged 0.4 points per game ... Notched first career steal against Lake Superior State (2/8) ... Recorded a steal in five minutes of playing time at Northwood (2/10) ... Compiled one offensive and one defensive rebound versus Benedict (S.C.) at the C.E. "Bighouse" Gaines Classic in Winston-Salem, N.C. (1/6) ... Recorded one assist in his first collegiate contest against Northwood (12/9) ... **1999-2000:** Did not play ... **1998-99:** Spent half the season as a redshirt under head coach Kevin Luke at GLIAC member Michigan Tech University in Houghton, Mich.

Named the team's Most Improved Player ... Earned Defensive Player of the Year honors as a senior at the Class A school.

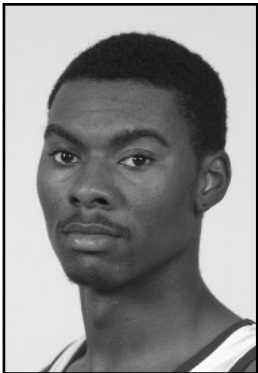

College: 2000-01: Played in 22 games ... Reached double-figures in scoring nine times ... Had 16 points and six rebounds in a win at Saginaw Valley State (1/25) ... Scored 16 points versus Wayne State (1/13) ... Grabbed 10 rebounds as FSU defeated Wisconsin-Parkside (12/22) ... Totaled 12 points in the season-opening win over NCAA Division I Oakland University (11/21) ... Registered seven points and nine rebounds versus Findlay (11/30) ... Averaged 8.7 points and 5.1 rebounds per contest ... Notched the eighth-best single-season block total in school history (26) ... Scored in every game he played in ... Ranked among the conference leaders in blocked shots at 1.18 blocks per game ... Had a team-high seven rebounds at Gannon (1/18) ... Blocked four shots and scored 16 points at Grand Valley State (1/22).

Coach Wilson on Guernsey: "Jeff has improved a great deal. He has improved his quickness and strength with a loss of weight and increased conditioning. He has also stepped up as one of our leaders."

College: 2000-01: Saw action in 23 contests ... Averaged 2.3 points per game and 1.6 rebounds per game ... Scored a career-high eight points and grabbed five rebounds in a win over Northwood (12/9) ... Sank two three-point baskets in three contests ... Was 3-of-4 from the floor (.750) and tallied seven points at St. Joseph's (11/27) ... Scored six points in a win at Northern Michigan (2/22) ... College: 2000-01: Started 14 games ... Played in all 24 contests ... Tallied a career-high 20 points at Lake Superior State (12/7) ... Had seven double-figure scoring performances ... Totaled 10 points and five rebounds versus Northwood (12/9) ... Registered 11 points and three assists against Benedict (S.C.) in the C.E. "Bighouse" Gaines Classic at Winston-Salem, N.C. ... Scored 11 points in a win over Saginaw Valley State (2/17) ... Led the squad with 77 assists and 32 steals ... Dished out 61 assists in 18 conference games ... 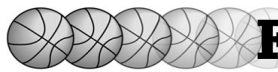

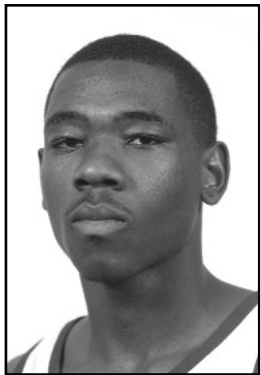

College: 2000-01: Started 24 of 26 games ... Ranked second on the squad in scoring at 10.1 points per game ... Scored 20 points at Gannon (1/18) ... Tallied 20 points and seven rebounds versus Benedict (S.C.) in the C.E. "Bighouse" Gaines Classic at Winston-Salem, N.C. (1/6) ... Had 15 double-digit scoring performances ... Totaled seven points and five rebounds in his first collegiate contest at NCAA Division I Oakland University (11/21) ... Dished out seven assists and scored 12 points at Southern Indiana (12/29) ... Registered 13 points as FSU won at Northern Michigan for the first time in 12 years (2/22) ... Scored 10 points or more in four of the final five games ... 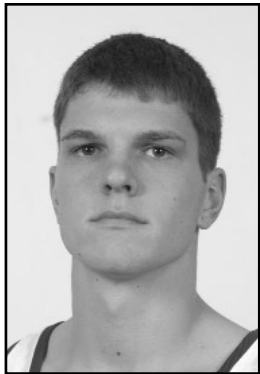
