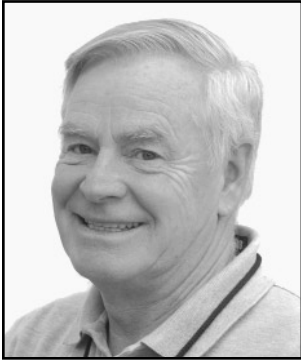


## BULLDOG STAFF/COACHING HISTORY



### DEAN DAVENPORT Basketball Consultant

**D**ean Davenport is in his first season as a consultant to the FSU men's basketball program. Davenport is no stranger to the FSU athletics department, however, as he previously was FSU's Athletics Director from 1979 to 1993.

During his tenure at Ferris, Davenport led the Bulldog athletics department to the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference President's Cup 12 consecutive years.

Davenport was instrumental in the planning of the FSU Sports Complex, the growth of women's intercollegiate athletics, the emergence of Ferris' NCAA Division I men's ice hockey program and the development of the athletics scholarship program.

A graduate of Central Michigan, Davenport was Ferris' acting director of the health, physical education and recreation division from 1977 to 1979

when he was appointed director of athletics. He also was an assistant men's basketball coach and coordinator of athletics at FSU prior to his appointment as athletics director.

While at Ferris, Davenport was a leader in the NCAA, serving on the nominating and men's sports committees. He also held positions on the honors, basketball rating and scholarship committees. Davenport served as president of the Central Collegiate Hockey Association, the Midwest Intercollegiate Football Conference and the GLIAC.

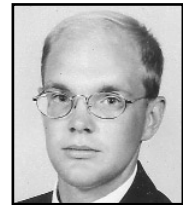
A basketball letterwinner at CMU, Davenport was the athletic director and head basketball coach at Iowa Wesleyan College before coming to Ferris in 1970. He has also held coaching stints at Traverse City, Petoskey and Grant High Schools in Michigan and was an assistant men's basketball coach at both Central Michigan and California State Northridge.

Davenport and his wife, Joyce, reside in Big Rapids.

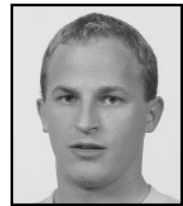

### MATT MILLER Student Assistant Coach

**M**att Miller, who earned four varsity letters as a Bulldog player from 1998 to 2002, is in his first season as a student assistant coach.

Miller, a native of Bridgman, Mich., tallied 486 points and 310 rebounds during his FSU career. He was named FSU's Most Valuable Teammate Award recipient as a senior in 2001-02 after scoring 8.9 points and grabbing 4.5 rebounds per contest.

A 1998 Bridgman High School graduate, Miller attained third-team *Detroit News* all-state accolades as a prep senior. He averaged 20 points, 15 rebounds and four assists per game while leading the Bees to a 17-2 mark in his senior campaign.

Miller, a first-team 1998 All-Red Arrow Conference honoree, was Bridgman's team captain and Most Valuable Player as a senior. He earned seven total varsity letters in basketball, baseball and soccer at Bridgman.

The son of Rex and Debbie Miller of Bridgman, Mich., Miller is presently completing his degree in business education at Ferris State. He lists woodworking as a hobby.
