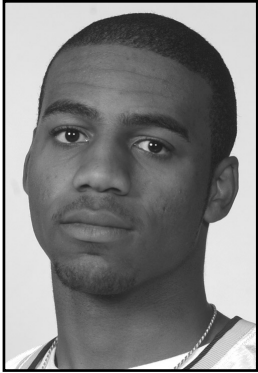


MEET THE 2004-05 BULLDOGS

College: 2004-05: Improved strength ... Among league's most athletic players ... Expected to progress fundamentally ... Has incredible reach and wing span ... **2003-04:** Saw action in 26 contests ... Started one game ... Totaled three double-figure scoring outings ... Had 14 points and eight rebounds at Saginaw Valley State (12/13) ... Scored 14 points and grabbed five boards versus Indianapolis (12/19) ... Placed tied for 13th in blocked shots (0.73 bpg) among league leaders ... Ranked third on squad in field goal percentage (.468) and was second in blocks ... Registered 11 points and six rebounds at NCAA Division I Central Michigan (11/17) ... Compiled nine points and five boards versus Northern Michigan (2/26) ... Blocked three shots in FSU's win over Michigan Tech (2/28) for the GLIAC North Division crown ... Had eight rebounds and three blocks versus Gannon (1/22) ... Scored eight points in lone start versus St. Xavier, Ill. (11/21) ... Converted four-of-four (1.000) field goal attempts for eight points vs. Mercyhurst (1/24) ... Played 399 minutes while averaging 4.3 points per game ... Tallied 111 points and 94 rebounds ... Totaled both one point and rebound in collegiate debut at Lewis, Ill. (11/15) ... Sank first career three-pointer in season finale vs. Northwood (3/2).

High School: A 2003 graduate of Bridgeport High School ... Averaged 21 points and 11 rebounds per game as a senior ... Led the Bearcats to a 14-7 overall record and a district semifinal finish in 2002-03 ... Attained first-team 2002-03 Associated Press Class B All-State recognition along with second-team honors from the *Detroit News* and fourth-team *Detroit Free Press* accolades ... Was a third-team *MichiganPreps.com* Class B All-State pick ... Two-time (2002-03) *Saginaw News* Class B First-Team All-Area honoree ... Received first-team 2002-03 Tri-Valley Conference East Division kudos for the second year ... Was a two-year letterwinner ... Guided the Bearcats to a district championship under head coach Tim Crawford in 2001-02 ... Also played football and ran track ... Broke the school's high jump record ... Played Amateur Athletic Union (AAU) basketball for the Michigan Mustangs.

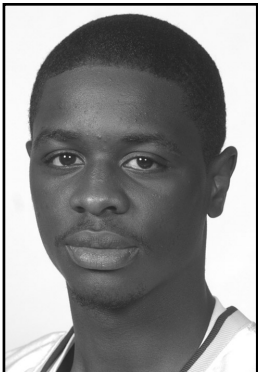

College: 2004-05: Asked to develop leadership role ... Capable of becoming league's top point guard ... Improved shooting range ... Serves as squad's quarterback ... **2003-04:** Made 27 starts ... Second-Team GLIAC North Division pick ... Named to GLIAC All-Defensive and All-Academic Teams ... Led league in assists (6.19 apg) and was fifth in steals (1.89 spg) ... Was squad's third-leading scorer (10.8 ppg) ... Had 17 double-digit scoring outings ... Dished out 13 assists vs. Grand Valley State (1/10) ... Scored 21 points vs. Michigan Tech (2/28) ... Compiled 19 points and nine assists at Ashland (12/6) ... Had eight or more assists in 11 contests ... Posted school's third-best seasonal assists total (167) ... Finished 16th nationally in assists ... GLIAC North Division Player of the Week (3/1) ... **2002-03:** Started all 26 contests ... Totaled 155 assists, which represented the fourth-highest single-season figure in school history ... Led team in assists (6.0 apg), was second in steals (1.9 spg) and fourth in scoring (11.3 ppg) ... Was GLIAC's assists leader, ranked third in assist/turnover ratio (1.96) and finished sixth in steals (1.9 spg) ... Registered a triple-double performance with 16 points, 13 assists and 10 steals vs. Calvin (11/26) ... Scored 22 points and had six rebounds at Olivet (12/14) ... Tallied 20 points at Lake Superior State (1/25) ... Recorded 15 double-figure scoring performances ... Led team in assists 19 times and in steals on 10 occasions ... Notched 10 assists or more in five outings ... Totaled 14 points, 10 assists and six rebounds vs. Lake Superior State (2/6) ... Averaged nine assists per game in 10 home appearances ... Ranked 19th nationally in assists per game (6.0 apg) ... **2001-02:** Attended Bowling Green State, but did not play basketball.

High School: A 2001 graduate of Scott High School in Toledo, Ohio ... Received third-team 2000-01 Ohio High School Athletic Association Division I All-State accolades ... Averaged 15.5 points per game as a senior while leading the Bulldogs to a conference title, district championship and regional runner-up finish during his prep career ... Two-time (2000-01) All-Toledo City League pick ... Named *Toledo Blade's* 2001 Player of the Year ... Prepped by Earl Morris.

Personal: Son of Dennis and Jackie Springs of Toledo, Ohio ... Born 10/22/82 in Toledo, Ohio ... Majoring in social studies ... Participated in Bowling Green State's Upward Bound college preparation program ... Father is employed by Ford Motor Company while his mother is a public school driver.
