**Daktronics, Inc. All-Great Lakes Region Women's Basketball Team announced,
Hillsdale's Cezat named Great Lakes Region Player of the Year**

EVANSVILLE, Ind.—Hillsdale's junior forward **Katie Cezat** was named the Daktronics, Inc. Division II Great Lakes Region Player of the Year in a vote by the regions sports information directors.

Cezat was named the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference's Player of the Year after leading the Chargers to a 23-3 overall record during the regular season and a 15-2 mark in GLIAC play. Cezat's 23.7 points and 12.5 rebounds per game were both GLIAC bests and spurred the Chargers to the GLIAC South Division title.

Joining Cezat on the first team was Ferris State senior forward/center Rachel Folcik, SIU Edwardsville senior guard/forward Amber Shelton, Quincy junior guard Jessica Keller, and Drury senior guard Molly Carter.

Folcik, who led the Bulldogs into the semi-finals of the GLIAC Tournament, is on the first team for the second consecutive year after averaging 20.1 points and 8.4 rebounds per game during the regular season.

Both Shelton and Carter are making the first team after earning second-team All-Region honors a year ago. Shelton led the Great Lakes Valley Conference in scoring during the regular season and got the Cougars into the GLVC Tournament with a fourth-place finish in the GLVC West Division.

Carter earned GLVC Player of the Year honors after leading the Panthers to a 24-3 overall mark during the regular season, including a league-best 16-3 mark in conference play. She also was named the GLVC Tournament Most Outstanding Player after leading Drury to the GLVC Tournament title.

Keller is making her first appearance on the All-Region team after a stellar year that saw her lead the Lady Hawks to a third-place finish in the GLVC West Division with a 19-8 overall record and a 14-5 mark in league play. Keller ranks second in the GLVC in scoring (20.3 ppg), fifth in rebounding (7.8 rpg), and first in assists (5.1 apg).

The Daktronics Division II All-Great Lakes Region second team was comprised of Northern Kentucky's senior center Angela Healy, Indianapolis's senior forward Karla Mast, Wisconsin-Parkside's senior guard Kayla Ming, Missouri S&T's junior forward Tamara McCaskill, and Northwood's junior forward Megan Starnes.

Members from the Daktronics All-Great Lakes Region first team will be on the All-America ballot.

The NCAA II Great Lakes Region Tournament is March 14-17 in Springfield, Missouri.
